Scheidegger, 2013-03-08 The idea of the present symposium was conceived a few years ago by the Working Group 3 WG3 of the Interunion Commission of Geodynamics ICG Now that its Program has been completed it was decided to present the results of that part of the activities of the WG3 indicated in the symposium title The writer was asked by the WG3 to coordinate the contributions The European Geophysical Society EGS kindly offered to host the symposium during its meeting in Vienna in September 1979 and Springer Verlag in Vienna agreed to publish a Proceedings volume of the Symposium These efforts are gratefully acknowledged The whole subject matter of the symposium was divided into 6 themes The first concerns in situ stress determinations the second deals with stresses as inferred from fault plane solutions of earthquakes the third geomorphic and geological effects of stresses the fourth petrofabrics and stresses the fifth recent displacements and the sixth geomechanical models Upon the recommendation of the WG3 contributors were invited to present papers falling under the themes mentioned The symposium how ever was also open to unsolicited contributors in the general call for papers for the EGS meeting It is hoped that the papers will present a fairly complete picture of the results obtained in the study of tectonic stresses in the Alpine Mediterranean region during the ten years of the duration of the International Geodynamics Program **Anatomy of an Orogen: The Apennines and Adjacent Mediterranean Basins** F. Raumer, Franz Neubauer, 2012-12-06 The Alps are an arched mountain chain stretching 1500 km between

Vienna and Graz in Austria and Genova in Italy They resulted from the collision of the African and Laurasian plates during Mesozoic and Tertiary times The high standard of knowledge attained over the last 30 years by the working groups on Alpine Metamorphism is well known and helped considerably to recognize pre Mesozoic elements in the Alps In Part I of this book the subdivision of the major Alpine units and pre Mesozoic palaeogeographic reconstructions are covered before discussion of the pre Mesozoic geology in Parts II III and IV It is understood that the Mesozoic and later events overprinted pre existing structures veiling the earlier history and the nature of protoliths Although the Alpine overprint does not facilitate the recognition of older structures pre Mesozoic basement units were recognized during the first beginnings of geological observations in the Alps about 200 years ago Fifty percent of the Alpine domain is underlain by basement units that have been unconformably covered since Permian and Mesozoic times This basement appears today in a complex pattern among the Alpine structures The history of their discovery and explanation parallel with a growing sophistication of research methods are the subject of the introductory chapter of Part II

Exposed Cross-Sections of the Continental Crust M.H. Salisbury, David M. Fountain, 2012-12-06 In the Fall of 1988 64 geologists and geophysicists from 11 countries met in Killarney Ontario on the north shore of Lake Huron to examine evidence that suggests that the continental crust is exposed in cross section at several key locations on the Earth's surface The meeting which was held under NATO auspices as an Advanced Study Institute was a landmark event in that it was the first time that many of the lead scientists working on these complexes in relative isolation around the world had ever gathered together to compare results The present volume is a compendium of the invited lectures given on the principle sections plus an array of supporting papers on these and other sections as well as on related topics such as crustal emplacement mechanisms deformation and rheology Nearly all of the best known sections are represented including the Ivrea Zone Calabria the Kapuskasing Zone Fiordland and many others It is our hope that this Volume will serve as a reference for Earth scientists who are trying to understand levels of the crust not normally exposed to view as well as a point of departure for new research and a teaching aid to new entrants in this relatively new field of study

Now in full colour and a larger format this third edition is a comprehensive update and expansion of the previous editions and represents a rigorous yet accessible guide to problem solving in this most integrative of geoscientific disciplines. Stanley, Forese-Carlo Wezel, 2012-12-06 The Mediterranean Sea nestled between Africa southern Europe and the Middle East may be envisioned as a complex picture puzzle comprising numerous intricate pieces many of which are already in place. A general image in terms of science has emerged although at this time large gaps are noted and some areas of the picture remain fuzzy and indistinct. In recent years this fascinating mind teasing puzzle image has become clearer with individual pieces more easily recognized and rapidly emplaced largely by means of multidisciplinary and multinational team efforts.
