

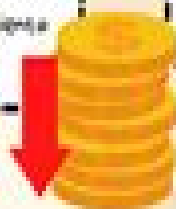

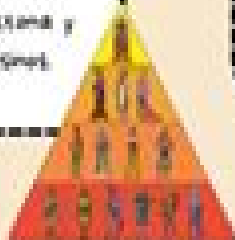

Imperio bizantino

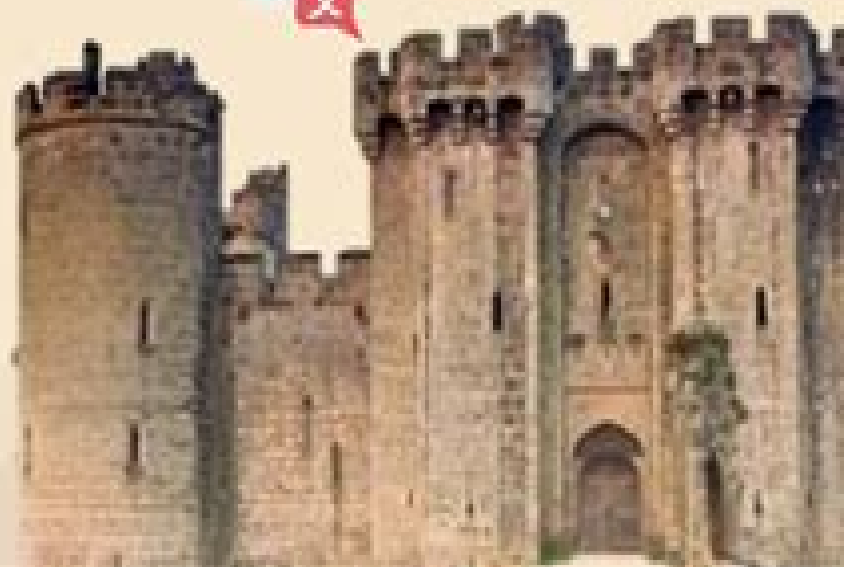
