they in effect silence venerable poets and cancel traditional formats Huxley's poetic personas either fail to preserve conventional forms or purposely sabotage them By 1920 Huxley became the parodic equivalent of the formative intelligences i e Dante Goethe and Lucretius who once synthesized their respective eras positively In this book author Jerome Meckier explicates most of Huxley's poems including Leda his masterpiece an ironical modern myth Meckier traces Huxley's development in terms of the poets he inserted in five of his eleven novels along with their poems.
