In courts women in particular were prosecuted and punished for insulting others or talking too much in a public setting. In literature both men and women were warned about women s propensity to gossip and quarrel while characters such as Noah s Wife and the Wife of Bath demonstrate the development of a stereotypically garrulous woman Visual representations such as depictions of women gossiping in church also reinforced the message that women s speech was likely to be disruptive and deviant
