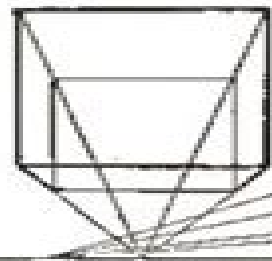


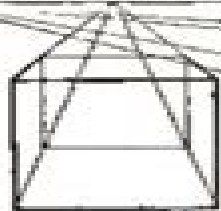
1. Position affects the apparent form of an object.

2. Distance affects the apparent size of an object; the further an object is from the eye, the smaller it will appear.

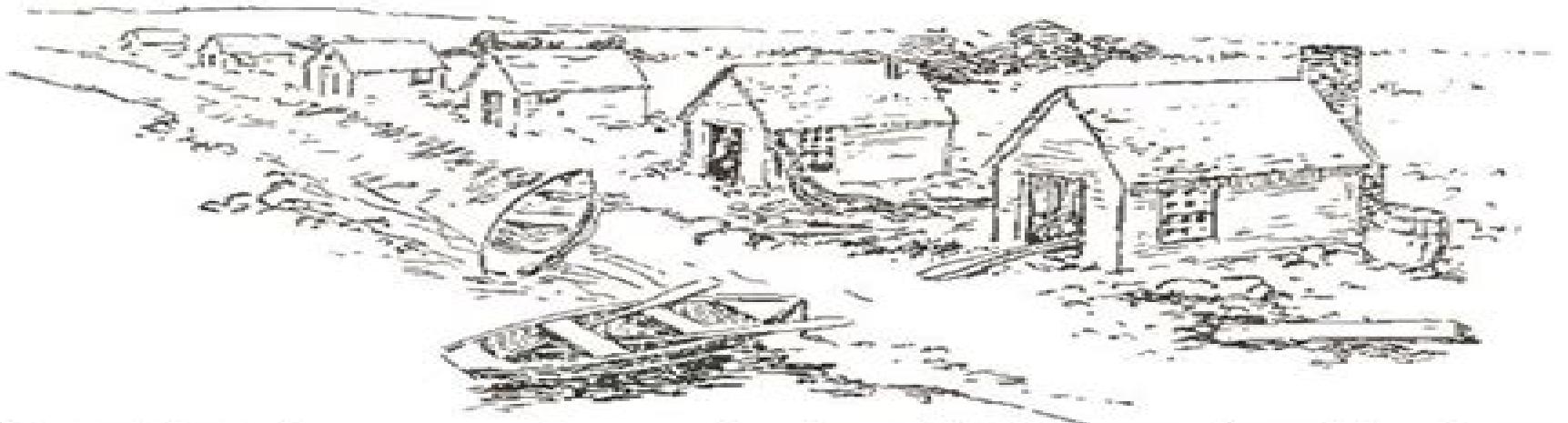


Illustration of apparent decrease in size with distance from the observer.
