person as expressive provides an understanding of the person as an embodied being that lives in the world and shares it with other embodied beings but in this very living and sharing moves beyond the material bounds of embodiment and constitutes the world as a world of meaning and value The notion of expression is not only crucial to making sense of Stein's own account of spirit but furthermore provides a way of understanding the person as inextricably bound up in community without compromising the individual In going out toward others in spiritual expression one not only forms community with the other one also becomes more oneself Thus Stein's understanding of spirit as fundamentally expressive helps make sense of what it means to be an individual human being and what it means to be a part of the human community This volume appeals to students and scholars working in phenomenology

Edith Stein Letters to Roman Ingarden Edith Stein, Hugh Candler Hunt, 2015-02-05 Edith Stein and Roman Ingarden both students of Edmund Husserl the founder of phenomenology corresponded extensively between 1917 and 1938 These 162 letters most published here for the first time reveal a friendship that spanned the adult lives of these two important 20th century thinkers Through Stein's letters the reader can follow her through her student days her conversion from Judaism to Catholicism her professional life and her decision to become a Carmelite nun in the Carmel of Cologne where she took the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross The letters end in 1938 when the Nazi threat escalating throughout Eastern Europe made correspondence difficult especially across national borders Four years later Edith Stein was arrested in the Netherlands by the Nazi SS transported to Auschwitz and was killed in the gas chambers Roman Ingarden survived World War II continued his academic work in Poland and died in 1970 Although Ingarden's letters to her have not been found Stein's to him also help us understand the life of this Polish phenomenologist and aesthetician his life in Poland his intellectual development his own writings and academic career and the editorial assistance Stein provided for all of the works he published in German Translated from the newest critical German edition by Dr Hugh Candler Hunt this premiere English edition of her correspondence volume 12 of ICS Publications Collected Works of Edith Stein gives us a fascinating and intimate window into Edith Stein's rich life and personality revealing her warmth and humor deep capacity for friendship and remarkable intellectual and spiritual depth Book has 13 photos bibliography and linked index

Being Unfolded Thomas Gricoski, William Desmond, 2020-02-07 *Being Unfolded* responds to the question What is the meaning of being for Edith Stein In *Finite and Eternal Being* Stein tentatively concludes that being is the unfolding of meaning Neither Stein nor her commentators have elaborated much on this suggestive phrase Thomas Gricoski argues that Stein's mature metaphysical project can be developed into an ontology of unfolding The differentiating factor of this ontology is its resistance to both existentialism and essentialism The ontology of unfolding is irreducibly relational *Being Unfolded* proceeds by testing a relational hypothesis against Stein's theory of the modes of being actual essential and mental being From the phenomenological perspective Gricoski examines Stein's theory of the relation of consciousness and being From the scholastic perspective he examines Stein's account of the relation of essence and existence in material being living

being and human being And from both perspectives he considers the relation of divine being to actual being and their essences This book is limited to Stein s theory of the meaning of being without making an explicit confrontation with Heidegger It offers two primary contributions to Stein studies a systematic analysis of Stein s modes of being especially essential being and an exposition and expansion of her overlooked concept of unfolding Being Unfolded also contributes to the broader field of contemporary metaphysics by developing Stein s theory of being as an experiment in fundamental ontology While other relational ontologies focus on relations between beings this exploration of unfolding examines being s inner self relationality

Teaching Women Philosophers Ruth Edith Hagengruber, 2024-08-30 This book expands the known canon by presenting arguments and concepts from women philosophers from all periods of the history of philosophy from antiquity to the present day The collaborative collection is an undertaking that emerged from intensive discussions on how to expand the philosophical canon which formed the conclusion of the Libori Summer School 2019 This Libori Summer School the third in a row was held to enhance the study of texts written by women philosophers from Antiquity up to now and intended to give opportunity to young scholars to connect and to build networks Presenting such a collection is even more urgent today because a diversification of the canon has long been called for Nevertheless to date there is little explicit material available for this purpose To make this book suitable for both academics and students it is structured in such a way that readers can use excerpts and individual chapters from it that suit their needs be it in moral philosophy politics or phenomenology etc Containing chapters on women such as Suor Juana Emilie Du Ch telet and Nisia Floresta and supplemented by contextualization namely by some brief biographical information and by the systematic integration of her argument into the debates of the respective periods this book is an important resource highlighting the achievements and value of women in philosophy and calling for a further diversification of the canon
