Contemplation In Action:

Contemplation and Action, 1996 This thesis examines from the writings of Ignatius Loyola founder of the Society of Jesus Ignatius synthesis of contemplation and action The main point of the thesis argues that although Ignatius followed the Western monastic tradition of contemplation nevertheless he innovated it by radically orienting contemplation to action making action virtually equal to or even more acceptable than contemplation He replaced the recitation of the divine office in choir considered the essential expression of contemplation with the dynamic formula finding God in all things Through a study of the historical and social environment in which Ignatius lived and of his main writings this thesis concludes that Ignatius was influenced in his synthesis by both the context of his times and the monastic tradition of contemplation It is also argued that although there is continuity between Ignatian contemplation and the monastic tradition there is a discontinuity as well Like the monastic tradition Ignatian contemplation had a Christocentric focus This Christocentric focus however was set within a highly Trinitarian backdrop Like the monastic tradition Ignatian contemplation was characterized by the use of the imaginative senses and motivated by the love of God but unlike the monastic tradition which made contemplation pre eminent Ignatian contemplation was oriented to apostolic service or action so that one finds God in all things *Traditional Modes of Contemplation and Action* Yūsuf Ībīsh, Peter Lamborn Wilson, 1977 *Contemplation and Action in World Religions* Yūsuf Ībīsh, Ileana Marculescu, 1978 **Augustine Through the Ages** Allan Fitzgerald, John C.
