# A Contemporary Trend in North American Theology: Process-thought and Christian Faith<sup>1</sup>

When the Faculty Board of Divinity kindly asked me to deliver a public lecture during my stay in Cambridge, I thought at once that my audience might be interested in hearing of current theological movements in the United States and Canada, since the lines of communication in Theology between you in Britain and us in North America are not always as open as they might be. And I was sufficiently immodest to think that the particular movement in which I myself am most involved might be of special interest to you, since very little is heard of it, so far as I can gather, on this side of the Atlantic. I refer to the group of theologians, of several denominational allegiances. who are concerned with what we in North America are now calling—for good or ill—' process-thought'. in its relationship to Christian faith and especially in the re-conception of that faith in our own day.

Let me begin by mentioning some names and some books. Among those who in one way or another are associated with this rather looselyconnected group are several theologians whose names and whose books are doubtless familiar to First, Professor Daniel Day Williams of Union Seminary in New York, the successor of Paul Tillich in the Chair of Philosophical Theology in that college, and author of God's Grace and Man's Hope as well as the little book Contemporary Theology. Then, Professor Schubert Ogden of the Perkins School of Theology in Dallas, Texas, whose Christ without Myth and whose translations of Bultmann and whose many articles in religious journals, mostly on the German demythologizing controversy, have attracted wide attention. At the University of Chicago Divinity School, Bernard Meland and Bernard Loomer have written several books and essays which deal with the wider philosophical issues of process-thought and Christian faith. In the field of Biblical studies, Professor John Knox of Union Seminary is the leading name among those influenced by this movement, as his

And if I may mention it, I myself have sought to use process-thought in three books, Rethinking the Christian Message, The Word Incarnate, and The Christian Understanding of Human Nature, attempts at re-statement of the Christian faith with special emphasis on the meaning of the Christian tradition, the doctrine of Christ, and the nature of man.

If one were looking for an ancestory to contemporary American process-thought, one would find it in the philosophers of emergent evolution. in the first three decades of this century: in the work of such writers as C. Lloyd-Morgan, Samuel. Alexander, and Jan Smuts. But its American. source is chiefly in Alfred North Whitehead, the Cambridge mathematician who in the mid-twenties. after several years in London, went to Harvard University as Professor of Philosophy to begin, as he put it, the third or philosophical phase of hiscareer. Several of his books, written whilst at Harvard, have been enormously influential on the movement with which we are concerned. of them: Science and the Modern World, Process and Reality, and Adventures of Ideas, are large and original works; although I think that three smaller volumes, Religion in the Making, Modes of Thought, and Symbolism, may be said to sum uphis thought and make it available in a way that only Adventures of Ideas can parallel. All of these are happily now reprinted in cheap paperbound. One of Whitehead's old students at editions. Harvard, Professor Charles Hartshorne, is the American philosopher who has developed most fully his teacher's principles and in several books chiefly Beyond Humanism, The Vision of God, Reality as Social Process, The Logic of Perfection, and a forthcoming Philosophy of Religion-hasrelated Whitehead's process-thinking to Christian faith.

But you are not interested in lists of names. So let me give you, first, a sketch of the general line of thought upon which this group build their theology; and, second, some illustrations of ways in which theological re-conception has been developed by them.
