- Giving in-person feedback

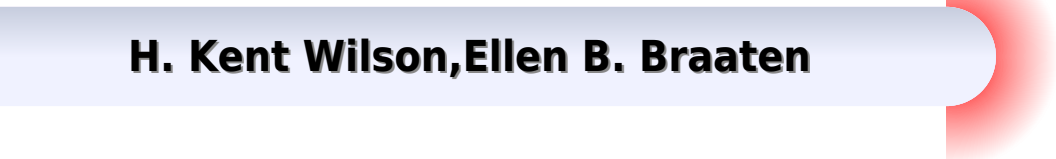
