its worth during the turbulent events of this period Religion and Reconciliation in Greek Cities provides a revised text and a secure meaning for both documents and interprets the gods the ritual and the social background in the light of much comparative material from other Greek cities Noel Robertson's approach rejects the usual assumptions based on moralizing literary works and in doing so restores to us an ancient nature religion which Greek communities adapted to their own practical purposes The Re-Imagined Text Jean I.
