will turn the tide of the war but he depends on the tenacity of these soldiers to break the resistance of the formidable Afrika Korps Bestselling author Tom Gilling recounts in vivid detail the brutal hand to hand fighting deadly artillery barrages and momentous tank battles that characterised the desert war culminating in two immense clashes involving hundreds of thousands of troops around an isolated Egyptian railway halt at El Alamein Rich in historical insight and heart pounding action *Start Digging You Bastards* brings to life the fateful conflict in the Egyptian desert evoking the desperate dust choked struggle through the eyes of the troops whose courage and endurance were tested to the very limit Bachelors, Bastards, and Nomadic Masculinity Robert Fagley, 2014-11-19 *Bachelors Bastards and Nomadic Masculinity* is firstly a thematic exploration of bachelor figures and male bastards in literary works by Guy de Maupassant and Andr Gide The coupling of Maupassant and Gide is appropriate for such an analysis not only because of their mutual treatment of illegitimacy but also because each writer represents varieties of bachelors and bastards from disparate social classes and subcultures each writing during contiguous moments of socio legal changes particularly related to divorce law and women s rights which consequently have great influence on the legal destiny of illegitimate or natural children Napoleon s Civil Code of 1804 provides the legal patriarchal framework for the period of this study of illegitimacy from about 1870 to 1925 The Civil Code saw numerous changes during this period The Naquet Law of 1884 which reestablished limited legal divorce represents the central socio legal event of the turn of the century in matters of legitimacy whereas the Franco Prussian War of 1870 and the First World War furnish chronological bookends for this book Besides through history law and sociology this book treats illegitimacy through the lens of various branches of gender and sexual theory particularly the study of masculinities and a handful of other important critical theories most importantly those of Michel Foucault Eve Sedgwick Todd Reeser Charles Stivale and Gilles Deleuze and F lix Guattari Bachelors and bastards are two principal players in the representation of illegitimacy in Maupassant and Gide but this study considers the theme of illegitimacy as extended beyond simple questions of legitimate versus illegitimate children The male bastard is only one of the Counterfeit characters examined in these authors fictional texts This book is divided into three parts which consider specific thematic elements of their bastard narratives Part One frames the representation in fiction of bachelor figures and how they contribute to or the roles they play in instances of illegitimacy Part Two springs from and develops the metaphor of the counterfeit coin whether represented by a bastard son an affected schoolboy a false priest or a pretentious litt rateur Part Three explains the concept of nomadic masculine practices such practices include nomadic styles of masculinity development as well as the bastard s nomadism

The Love Story in Shakespearean Comedy Anthony J. Lewis, 2021-10-21 In this fascinating study Anthony J Lewis argues that it is the hero himself rejecting a woman he apprehends as a threat who is love's own worst enemy Drawing upon classical and Renaissance drama iconography and a wide range of traditional and feminist criticism Lewis demonstrates that in Shakespeare the actions and reactions of hero and heroine are contingent upon social setting father son relations patriarchal restrictions on women and cultural assumptions about gender appropriate behavior This compelling analysis shows how Shakespeare deepened the familiar love stores he inherited from New Comedy and Greek romance Beginning with a penetrating analysis of the hero's contradictory response to sexual attraction Lewis's discussion traces the heroine's reaction to abandonment and slander and the lover's subsequent parallel descents into versions of bastardy and death In arguing that comedy's happy ending is the product of the gender role reversals brought on by their evolving relationship itself Lewis shows in meticulous detail how sexual stereotypes influence attitudes and restrict behavior This perceptive discussion of male response to family and of female response to rejection will appeal to Shakespeare scholars and students as well as to the theater community Lewis's persuasive argument that Shakespeare's heroes and heroines are from the first three dimensional figures far removed from the stock types of Plautus Terence and his continental sources will prove a valuable contribution to the ongoing feminist reappraisal of Shakespeare

Religion and Reconciliation in Greek Cities Noel Robertson, 2009-12-01 Two Greek cities which in their time were leading states in the Mediterranean world Selinus in Sicily and Cyrene in Libya set up inscriptions of the kind called sacred laws but regulating worship on a larger scale than elsewhere Selinus in the mid fifth century B C Cyrene in the late fourth In different ways the content and the format of both inscriptions are so unusual that they have baffled understanding At Selinus a large lead tablet with two columns of writing upside down to each other is thought to be a remedy for homicide pollution arising from civil strife but most of it remains obscure and intractable The gods who are named and the ritual that is prescribed have been misinterpreted in the light of literary works that dwell on the sensational Instead they belong to agrarian religion and follow a regular sequence of devotions the upside down columns being reversed midway through the year with magical effect Gods and ritual were selected because of their appeal to ordinary persons Selinus was governed by a long enduring oligarchy which made an effort appearing also in the economic details of sacrifice to reconcile rich and poor At Cyrene a long series of rules were displayed on a marble block in the premier shrine of Apollo They are extremely diverse both costly and trivial customary and novel and eighty years of disputation have brought no agreement as to the individual meaning or general significance In fact this mixture of things is carefully arranged to suit a variety of needs of rich and poor of citizens of long standing and of new comers probably of Libyan origin In one instance the same agrarian deities appear as at Selinus It is the work once more of a moderate oligarchy which on other evidence proved

its worth during the turbulent events of this period Religion and Reconciliation in Greek Cities provides a revised text and a secure meaning for both documents and interprets the gods the ritual and the social background in the light of much comparative material from other Greek cities Noel Robertson's approach rejects the usual assumptions based on moralizing literary works and in doing so restores to us an ancient nature religion which Greek communities adapted to their own practical purposes

The Re-Imagined Text Jean I. Marsden, 2014-07-15 Shakespeare's plays were not always the inviolable texts they are almost universally considered to be today The Restoration and eighteenth century committed what many critics view as one of the most subversive acts in literary history the rewriting and restructuring of Shakespeare's plays Many of us are familiar with Nahum Tate's audacious adaptation of King Lear with its resoundingly happy ending but Tate was only one of a score of playwrights who adapted Shakespeare's plays Between 1660 and 1777 more than fifty adaptations appeared in print and on the stage works in which playwrights augmented substantially cut or completely rewrote the original plays The plays were staged with new characters new scenes new endings and underlying all this novelty new words Why did this happen And why in the later eighteenth century did it stop These questions have serious implications regarding both the aesthetics of the literary text and its treatment for the adaptations manifest the period's perceptions of Shakespeare As such they demonstrate an important evolution in the definition of poetic language and in the idea of what constitutes a literary work In *The Re-Imagined Text* Jean I. Marsden examines both the adaptations and the network of literary theory that surrounds them thereby exploring the problems of textual sanctity and of the author's relationship to the text As she demonstrates Shakespeare's works and English literature in general came to be defined by their words rather than by the plots and morality on which the older aesthetic theory focused a clear step toward our modern concern for the word and its varying levels of signification
