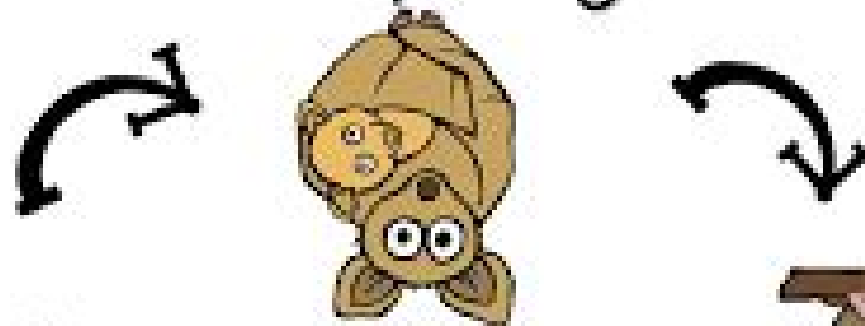
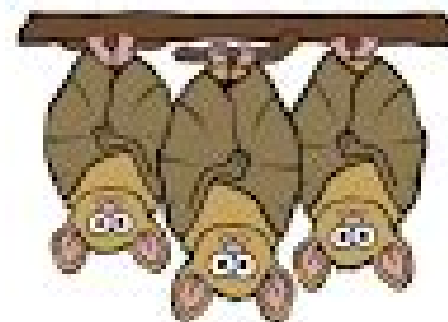


Bat Life Cycle



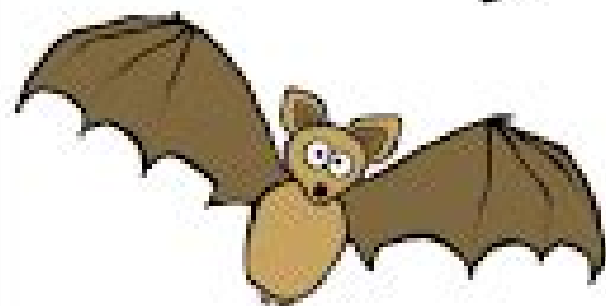
A bat pup is born. Mother bats usually have only one pup.
