The political geography of contemporary Britain edited by J Mohan; Macmillan Education, Basingstoke, Hants (distributed in the USA by Sheridan House, New York), 1989, 303 pages, £30.00 cloth, £8.95 paper (US: \$39.50, \$19.95)

Another account of the changing geography of 'contemporary' Britain may not these days be the most innovative of publications, even when 'political' is added to the title. But any initial reluctance to read this book should, at least in part, be offset by the breadth of coverage promised by its fifteen chapters and by the array of contributing authors who are among the best-known geographers in Britain today. In gathering together such a collection, Mohan is to be congratulated.

The motivation for the book is spelt out by Mohan in his introduction: to provide a "comprehensive introduction and sourcebook for those concerned with understanding the changing human geography of Britain". It is the account of these changes, particularly those of the past two decades, and the reasons for them that are the overriding concerns of the chapters that go to make up this book. The editorial perspective presented by Mohan suggests that the end of 'consensus politics' (the end is claimed as a characteristic of the 1980s during the three terms of Thatcher-led Conservative government) has had a decisive impact in this respect. The relative contribution of postwar secular trends on the one hand, and of the 'radical' policies of Thatcherism on the other, to the contemporary geography of Britain is a recurring theme. In chapter 1 the nature and origins of a range of Thatcherite policies are considered explicitly, and the issue of 'continuity or discontinuity' with regard to the processes that go to explain the recorded changes in the country's geography is taken up by several of the authors in their coverage of more specific topics [for example, in the examination of nationalised industries (chapter 7), in the consideration of evolving transport policies (chapter 11), and environmental politics (chapter 15)].

In his useful introduction Mohan identifies a number of other common themes: a concern with the changing boundary between the private and public spheres of operation; the changing character of the state and the nature of state intervention; and the emergence of a 'politics of inequality' based on race (segregation), gender (feminisation of poverty), and class. One further issue, which received perhaps rather less consistent coverage, can also be identified: the varied fate of social and political movements as seen in the checkered history of nationalism (chapter 3), the emergence of local opposition to central control and direction (chapter 5), the decline of trade unions (chapter 8), and the emergence of an environmental and ecological movement (chapter 15).

The initial chapters of the book take up a broad stance. Gamble (chapter 1) examines the general nature of Conservative policies and especially the claim for the end to the so-called postwar consensus, whereas Taylor (chapter 2) looks at the declining world position of the United Kingdom and its increasing interest in Europe. Anderson (chapter 3) considers the rise and fall of domestic nationalisms and their threat or otherwise to the territorial integrity of the country; Johnston and Pattie examine the changing polarisations in electoral geography (chapter 4); Goodwin and Duncan reflect on the crisis of the local state (chapter 5); and Martin (chapter 6) concludes the general chapters with an examination of deindustrialisation and the nature of state intervention. To observe that none of these chapters introduces much new material or a new interpretation beyond what has seen publication elsewhere, often by the same authors, is not to denigrate their usefulness for they draw together a wealth of illustrative material and provide a coherent synthesis of concepts; in effect contributing to the stated 'sourcebook' purpose of the publication.

The remaining chapters are more focused in their coverage, examining, for instance, the nationalised industries (Hudson, chapter 7); trade unions (Massey and Painter, chapter 8); race and segregation (Smith, chapter 9) and the questions of gender and the position of women (McDowell, chapter 10). In addition, for the list is impressively long, Whitelegg looks
