Hoppin,1881 **The Homiletic Writings of Archbishop Wulfstan** Joyce Tally Lionarons,2010 First full study of the homilies of Archbishop Wulfstan bringing out their most characteristic themes and concerns The prodigious writings of Archbishop Wulfstan d 1023 encompass secular laws religious canons political theory and homilies sermons despite their importance however the homilies have not received the critical attention they deserve a gap which this book seeks to fill It focuses on three particular aspects the re establishment of the Wulfstan homiletic canon Wulfstan s processes of composition and revision as manifested in their manuscript variants and his characteristic themes and concerns These include adherence to secular and divine law the keeping of Christian feasts and fasts the payment of church dues and tithes social justice for the poor absolute clerical celibacy and sexual continence for the laity repentance prayer and penance and the continual reminder both pre and post millennium that the end of the world is close at hand Wulfstan s homilies indicate that for the English to heed his warnings they would have to be persuaded or if necessarily legally coerced to adhere to the dictates of a Holy Society and their influence can be seen in his law codes where the book argues that even in coercion the archbishop sought to teach and to persuade JOYCE TALLY LIONARONS teaches in the English Department at Ursinus College Pennsylvania

Wessel Wessels,2024-03-29 This book pursues the question of consciousness and thought through the art of preaching in a postcolonial era Indeed the past has bestowed upon the present the legacy of colonization and in the South African context apartheid However the endeavor of postcolonizing theology and homiletics is a contentious space that has not been settled This book promotes a counterargument to the prevalent directions of decolonization by focusing on three themes of importance consciousness perspective and identity through the insights of primary postcolonial sources

Dialogical Preaching Marlene Ringgaard Lorensen, Ph.D.,2013-11-20 Dialogical Preaching Bakhtin Otherness and Homiletics explores the genre of preaching in light of theories of dialogicity and carnivalization developed by Mikhail Bakhtin The Bakhtinian approach to preaching evokes ways in which historical acts and embodied experiences are transcribed in literary genres The theories of carnivalization manifest the dynamic other oriented interaction between reflexive texts and embodied acts Experiences of otherness and difference play a central role in human communication as well as in theological descriptions of the relationship between God and humans One of the central aims of this book is to explore ways in which others different from the designated preacher influence contemporary preaching practices and in that sense can be seen as co authors As material for this investigation the book provides analyses of four theologians who have contributed significantly to contemporary homiletical developments namely those of the American homileticians Charles Campbell John S McClure and James H Harris and the Danish Systematic Theologian Svend Bjerg The homiletical analyses lead to the thesis that the dialogical encounter between author and addressees analyzer and analyzed is one of the conditions of interpretation and communication rather than a disturbance The communication theoretical and practical theological analyses are discussed in light of Kierkegaard s Barth s and J ngel s emphasis on the qualitative difference between God and

humans These concluding reflections suggest ways in which inter human otherness can function as a dynamically conjoining rather than mutually exclusive difference between God as the Wholly Other and other wise humans
