Park, 2011-10-12 Provision of efficient resuscitation is mandatory to the successful functioning of all hospital wards and departments Failure to provide such a service increases morbidity and mortality Resuscitation falls largely into the domain of the anaesthetist However an anaesthetist is not always instantly available and resuscitation has to be initiated by those in other specialities who have had little or no formal training in resuscitation techniques The purpose of this book is to guide those involved in resuscitation in the indications and methods of resuscitation Its creation and contents were stimulated by noting the difficulties encountered in both teaching centres and provincial hospitals Basic is included in the title to emphasize that with the exception of the acid base laboratory the apparatus is simple and available in all hospitals Furthermore basic indicates the authors intention to limit their discussion on resuscitation to that involved in the first hour following the start of treatment Successful treatment during these 60 minutes and very often the first few minutes is often vital in the saving of life Further management can then be decided by the appropriate specialist

The students' practical skills, willingness to act, and knowledge of stroke symptoms, symptoms of acute myocardial infarction (AMI), and lifestyle factors were assessed directly after training and at 6 months using the Laerdal PC Skill Reporting system and entered into a modified version of the Cardiff test scoring sheet and a questionnaire. The Cardiff test resulted in a total score of 12.48 points, and the questionnaire resulted in a total score of 0.7 points for stroke symptoms, 0.9 points for symptoms of AMI, and 0.6 points on lifestyle factors. Study IV is based on retrospective data from the national quality register, the Swedish registry of cardiopulmonary resuscitation 2010-2014. Results A total of 1339 students were included in the CPR training intervention. The DVD-based group was superior to the app-based group in CPR skills with a total score of 35 SD 4.0 vs 33 SD 4.2 points directly after training. p
