where I had happily lived in a small clapboard house surrounded by pines I can hear my mother in her strong accent saying she didn't want a dryer even when we could finally afford one Our sheets won't smell of trees and sunlight anymore Long Lens represents forty years of Peter Makuck's work including twenty five new poems With precise language Makuck's imagery evokes spiritual longing love loss violence and transcendence His subjects include the aftermath of the 1970 killings at Kent State University scuba diving on an offshore shipwreck flying through a storm in a small plane rescuing a boy caught in a rip tide and lucid observations of spinner sharks a gray fox a spider and a pelican tangled in a fishing line Peter Makuck taught at East Carolina University from 1976 to 2006 where he founded Tar River Poetry He was 2008 Lee Smith Chair in Creative Writing at North Carolina State University Winner of the Brockman Award and the Charity Randall Citation he lives on Bogue Banks one of North Carolina's barrier islands

Selected Poems of Amy Clampitt Amy Clampitt, 2011-02-22

When Amy Clampitt's first collection *The Kingfisher* was published it was hailed as that rare first book that signals a major poet in full bloom Los Angeles Times Its author was sixty three years old Over the next eleven years Clampitt produced four additional major collections Now the most essential poems from these five volumes are gathered together Clampitt was an impassioned observer of the natural world the delights of which color many of these poems writing of the fog she described a stuff so single it might almost be lifted folded over crawled underneath or slid between as nakedness caressingsheets Such was the texture of her language too She was a traveler reporting back from England and Greece from California and Maine and from her native Midwest An Iowa transplant to New York the descendant of pioneers she wrote of prairies and subways of the movements of wildflowers people and ideas and of the widespread modern experience of uprootedness Here is a treasure of Amy Clampitt's verse for those who are reading her for the first time as well as for those who have long admired her

Spillway Ian Pople, 2022-06-30 Ian Pople is a man of the world He has travelled and taught in the UK Greece Sudan and Saudi Arabia His poems explore England the larger world and how changing perspectives readjust the sense of England and of home They deal with borders crossings closing boundaries They are about transitions in space and time the ways life and relationships change and adapt to illness love estrangement and loss The traveller changes identities as he moves responding to different surroundings and the early poems collected here provide a varied retrospect moving through Africa Europe and Asia so that we read the more recent work from a different perspective The travel poems explore the range of reactions appropriations and misappropriations as physical and psychological boundaries are crossed More recent writing responds to music and the visual arts using assemblages or bricolage to convey the painfully familiar experience of displacement dislocation There are poems that answer back to figures from jazz history Roland Kirk Dupree Bolton and Pat Metheny among them It is wonderful to encounter such an accomplished and varied body of work which shares with us its vivid spaces and tones Pople a lucid critic of modern and contemporary especially American poetry is an original artist in his own right

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
