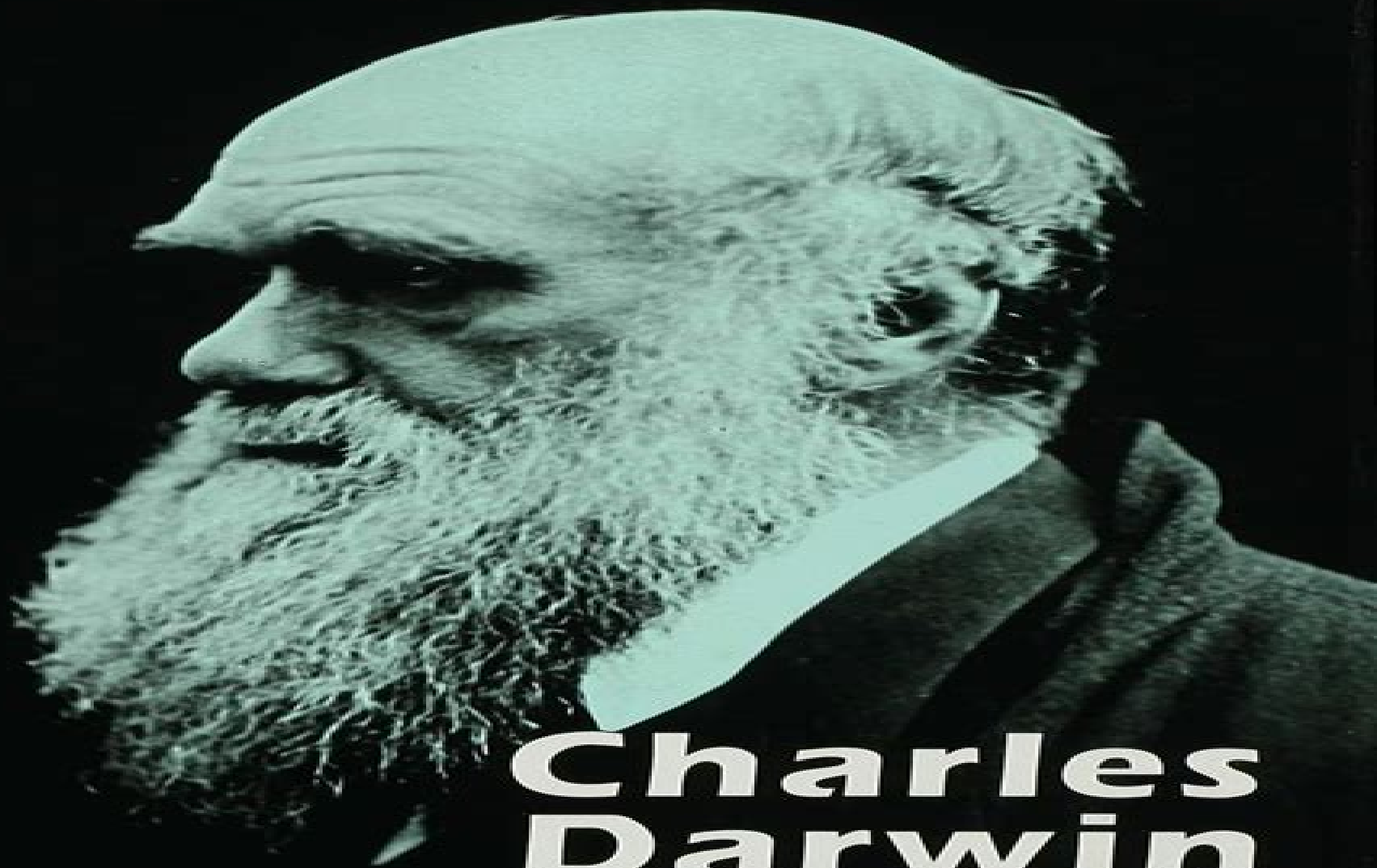

Charles Darwin Harold Orel, 2000 This selection of essays allows the reader to learn more about Darwin the family man as well as the context of Darwin's achievements in several developing research fields of the Victorian Age Darwin knew and cultivated the friendship of such scientists as Sir Joseph Hooker Alfred Russel Wallace Richard Owen Adam Sedgwick and Thomas Henry Huxley He conducted an enormous correspondence with all who could aid him in his work Their name is legion it is sampled here and constitutes one of the marvels of Darwin's century *The Reception of Darwinian Evolution in Britain, 1859-1909* Martin Hewitt, 2024-10-20 The Reception of Darwinian Evolution in Britain 1859 1909 Darwinism's Generations uses the impact of Charles Darwin's *On the Origin of Species* 1859 in the 50 years after its publication to demonstrate the effectiveness of a generational framework for understanding the cultural and intellectual history of Britain in the nineteenth century It challenges conventional notions of the Darwinian Revolution by examining how people from across all sections of society actually responded to Darwin's writings Drawing on the opinions and interventions of over 2 000 Victorians drawn from an exceptionally wide range of archival and printed sources it argues that the spread of Darwinian belief was slower more complicated more stratified by age and ultimately shaped far more powerfully by divergent generational responses than has previously been recognised In doing so it makes a number of important contributions It offers by far the richest and most comprehensive account to date of how contemporaries came to terms with the intellectual and emotional shocks of evolutionary theory It makes a compelling case for taking proper account of age as a fundamental historical dynamic and for the powerful generational patternings of the effects that age produced It demonstrates the extent to which the most common sub periodisation of the Victorian period are best understood not merely as constituted by the exigencies of events but are also formed by the shifting balance generational influence Taken together these insights present a significant challenge to the ways historians currently approach the task of describing the nature and experience of historical change and have fundamental implications for our current conceptions of the shape and pace of historical time

Since that date, through the kindness of various correspondents, additional letters have been received among them may be mentioned those written by Mr Darwin to Mr Belt, Lady Derby, Hugh Falconer, Mr Francis Galton, Huxley, Lyell, Mr John Morley, Max Muller, Owen, Lord Playfair, John Scott Thwaites, Sir William Turner, John Jenner Weir. But the material for our work consisted in chief part of a mass of letters which for want of space or for other reasons were not printed in the Life and Letters. We would draw particular attention to the correspondence with Sir Joseph Hooker. To him Mr Darwin wrote with complete freedom, and this has given something of a personal charm to the most technical of his letters. There is also much correspondence hardly inferior in biographical interest with Sir Charles Lyell, Fritz Muller, Mr Huxley, and Mr Wallace. From this unused material we have been able to compile an almost complete record of Mr Darwin's work in a series of letters now published for the first time. We have however in a few instances repeated paragraphs or in one or two cases whole letters from the Life and Letters where such repetition seemed necessary for the sake of clearness or continuity

Origins of Darwin's Evolution J. David Archibald, 2017-10-10 Historical biogeography, the study of the history of species through both time and place, first convinced Charles Darwin of evolution. This field was so important to Darwin's initial theories and line of thinking that he said as much in the very first paragraph of *On the Origin of Species* (1859) and later in his autobiography. His methods included collecting mammalian fossils in South America, clearly related to living forms, tracing the geographical distributions of living species across South America, and sampling peculiar fauna of the geologically young Galapagos Archipelago that showed evident affinities to South American forms. Over the years Darwin collected other evidence in support of evolution, but his historical biogeographical arguments remained paramount so much so that he devoted three full chapters to this topic in *On the Origin of Species*. Discussions of Darwin's landmark book too often give scant attention to this wealth of evidence, and we still do not fully appreciate its significance in Darwin's thinking. In *Origins of Darwin's Evolution*, J. David Archibald explores this lapse, showing how Darwin first came to the conclusion that instead of various centers of creation, species had evolved in different regions throughout the world. He also shows that Darwin's other early passion, geology, proved a more elusive corroboration of evolution. *On the Origin of Species* has only one chapter dedicated to the rock and fossil record, as it then appeared too incomplete for Darwin's evidentiary standards. Carefully retracing Darwin's gathering of evidence and the evolution of his thinking, *Origins of Darwin's Evolution* achieves a new understanding of how Darwin crafted his transformative theory

Lincoln and Darwin James Lander, 2010-09-20 Born on the same day in 1809, Abraham Lincoln and Charles Darwin were true contemporaries. Though shaped by vastly different environments, they had remarkably similar values, purposes, and approaches. In this exciting new study, James Lander places these two iconic men

side by side and reveals the parallel views they shared of man and God While Lincoln is renowned for his oratorical prowess and for the Emancipation Proclamation as well as many other accomplishments his scientific and technological interests are not widely recognized for example many Americans do not know that Lincoln is the only U S president to obtain a patent Darwin on the other hand is celebrated for his scientific achievements but not for his passionate commitment to the abolition of slavery which in part drove his research in evolution Both men took great pains to avoid causing unnecessary offense despite having abandoned traditional Christianity Each had one main adversary who endorsed scientific racism Lincoln had Stephen A Douglas and Darwin had Louis Agassiz With graceful and sophisticated writing Lander expands on these commonalities and uncovers more shared connections to people politics and events He traces how these two intellectual giants came to hold remarkably similar perspectives on the evils of racism the value of science and the uncertainties of conventional religion Separated by an ocean but joined in their ideas Lincoln and Darwin acted as trailblazers leading their societies toward greater freedom of thought and a greater acceptance of human equality This fascinating biographical examination brings the mid nineteenth century discourse about race science and humanitarian sensibility to the forefront using the mutual interests and pursuits of these two historic figures

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
