Around Countesthorpe Henrietta Schultka, Anne True, 1999 This fascinating book of over 200 old photographs depicts people scenes and events from everyday life in the villages of Countesthorpe Willoughby Waterleys Peatling Magna Foston Kilby Newton Harcourt and Wistow It illustrates the changing face of these villages during the past 100 years with the use of many photographs that have never been published before Countesthorpe was an open village with no principal landowner Non conformity had a particular influence on its residents and the images of the village reflect this diversity Local personalities and customs are featured together with scenes of agricultural life developing modes of transport the unique Cottage Homes and elements of both World Wars By contrast the closed villages of Willoughby Peatling Magna Kilby and Newton Harcourt were dominated by one of more large landowners Scenes of Willoughby feature its early brick buildings Photographs of Newton Harcourt are linked to the Goddard family as well known architects Tranquil views of Kilby create feelings of nostalgia as do the traditional sights of Peatling Magna s village life Foston and Wistow were depopulated for sheep grazing and consequently became deserted Wistow Hall however remains famous for its connections with Charles I and the Battle of Naseby This captivating collection of images will provoke memories of local history and inspire a new generation to be interested in their past

Around Countesthorpe Revisited Ann True, Hettie Schultka, 2011 This fascinating follow up to *Around Countesthorpe* brings together over 220 archive images many previously unpublished capturing local scenes vanished vistas and the people who lived and worked in and around Countesthorpe during the last century Each image is accompanied by a detailed caption bringing the past to life and describing many aspects of life in these communities including chapters on work industry and local events and providing a vital record of lost landscapes and past practices Life in some of the surrounding villages is also featured including Willoughby Waterleys Peatling Magna Peatling Parva Bruntingthorpe Kilby Foston Newton Harcourt and Wistow This book will appeal to everyone with an interest in the history of Countesthorpe and will also awaken memories of a bygone time for all who know this beautiful part of Leicestershire

Laker, 2019-04-11 Time Gone By is a comforting children's tale about a group of mice faced with the death of a loved one This story is set in an abandoned railway station in the small village of Countesthorpe Leicestershire England After the group's storyteller dies Titania the Queen of the Fairies bestows the storyteller role on a naughty little mouse named Key At first the Railway Mice are confused and annoyed Why did Titania give Key such an important role Blackberry the wisest mouse asks the other mice to give Key a chance The Queen clearly sees something in Key that we don't she tells them At first Key is nervous but everyone pulls together to support and encourage him As he tells the exciting story of The Adventures of Harold Mouse Key embellishes the tale with actions and slowly brings a ray of light into what had been a sad dark time for the Railway Mice More than death this story is about the celebration of life living life to its fullest and caring for those around you Does Key succeed in his new role as the Railway Mice of Countesthorpe's storyteller Only time will tell One thing for sure though is Key's ability to keep everyone entertained with his bright and cheery personality **GREBO!** Rich Deakin, 2021-10-07 West Midlands 1980s home to heavy metal Black Sabbath and Judas Priest are household names but over the smoking chimneys and factory yards something new and equally ugly forms Grebo was a media constructed music genre that even today sends a shudder down the spines of discerning music fans and critics A homegrown proto grunge counterpart to the likes of Butthole Surfers Mudhoney early Nirvana Alice In Chains and Soundgarden in the US grebo was a British phenomenon that drew on an eclectic range of influences from punk 60s garage and psychedelia through to 70s heavy rock and thrash metal It foreshadowed rave culture and was steeped in class politics GAYE BYKERS ON ACID and CRAZYHEAD hailed from Leicester They were not the first bands to be labelled grebo but they were the most unashamedly unkempt and came to be considered its greatest exponents They were a burst of dirty thunder and almost no one liked them Based on interviews with band members friends fans and roadies this book is an uncompromising history of an overlooked music scene Rich Deakin charts its course via the changing fortunes of the Bykers and Crazyhead taking us on the booze filled tour buses behind the dodgy deals and onto the international stage and back again with a pitstop for a rock movie that swallows lots of money Their careers were short but the two bands managed to shake up the UK indie scene and along the way became Britain's unlikely ambassadors of rock following the collapse of Soviet Russia Strap yourself in for a rocket ride of a book This is GREBO the complete loud and lousy story **Tea Shop Walks in Leicestershire & Rutland** Paul A. It is a service provided within an economy which is in recession and consequently faces continuous demands for savings. It is in recession within itself with a dramatic reduction in pupil numbers and accompanying school closures and loss of teaching jobs. Finally those working within it feel that it has lost its position of pre-eminence and respect in the fight against social problems; it faces criticism from all sides and repeated calls for better value for money. First published in 1986, *Education in Recession* explores the crisis brought about by this recession. The author focuses upon those who administer the cuts: the local authorities and in particular one County Shire. He traces the changing circumstances in which local government and education have found themselves since the post-war growth period and examines what now seems to be a 'cuts culture'. The effect upon local government schools, teachers and pupils of recent changes is analysed and portents for the future are studied with considerable concern. Throughout the study of Shire is linked to the wider national scene and related to the debate about the nature of education and the organizations which control it. This book should be read by those in the teaching profession and those about to enter it and those in local government who face the problem of continually finding savings in the service they have striven to build up. It will also be of interest to students and researchers of education.
