How Do You Treat HIV and AIDS?

AIDS can't be cured but people can live for many years with proper medical care. Antiretroviral medications can greatly reduce the level of HIV in the body when they are taken properly.

This type of medication can't repair damage to organs and systems in the patient's body so it is very important that people discover they are positive as quickly as possible so that they can start taking medication. People who take antiretroviral treatments will take them for their whole lives.



Did You Know...?

AIDS does not kill people - but other infections that are usually easy to recover from, like pneumonia and diarrhoea, are often fatal for people with AIDS because of their poor immune systems.

Treatment and Support

If you have tested positive for HIV it is very important that you start antiretroviral treatment as soon as possible. The only way to manage the damage the virus does to your immune system is with treatment, people living with HIV need to take their medicine every day.

Rights of people with HIV and AIDS

People living with HIV and AIDS have the same rights as everyone else. People with HIV and AIDS should not be discriminated against. No one can be forced to take an HIV test. HIV test results are private and confidential.

What Is HIV?

HIV stands for Human Immunodeficiency Virus. The virus attacks the body's immune (defence) system. Most people who are infected with the virus go on to develop AIDS but people can have HIV for years without having AIDS.

People with HIV can take antiretroviral medication which helps control the level of the virus in the body but there is no cure.

Regularly testing for HIV will help you to know your HIV status. This will allow you to get treatment as soon as possible and ensure that you don't spread the virus to others.

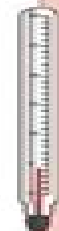
HIV is found in body fluids. It is mainly passed on through unprotected sex. You can also get the virus by sharing needles and from mother to child during pregnancy, labour and breastfeeding.

HIV and AIDS

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AIDS moves through four different stages:

- 1** Stage one: the person is HIV-positive but sometimes has no symptoms, except for some short-term symptoms such as flu-like symptoms, sore throat, fever and a rash on the chest. Stage one can last several years, during which the person might have no symptoms at all.
- 2** Stage two: the person starts getting more illnesses such as ear infections, frequent flu and skin problems.
- 3** Stage three: the person may start losing a lot of weight and get sick for longer stretches of time. Illnesses such as mouth ulcers, pneumonia, a long-lasting fever and tuberculosis.
- 4** Stage four: the person is very sick due to a very weak immune system. Illnesses such as pneumonia, bad diarrhoea, toxoplasmosis and meningitis are common in these patients. Patients at this stage are now said to have AIDS if their white blood cell count goes below 200 (normal cell count is between 500 to 1500).
