Foster, 2008-07-18 Agrarian Landscapes in Transition researches human interaction with the earth With hundreds of acres of agricultural land going out of production every day the introduction spread and abandonment of agriculture represents the most pervasive alteration of the Earth's environment for several thousand years What happens when humans impose their spatial and temporal signatures on ecological regimes and how does this manipulation affect the earth and nature's desire for equilibrium Studies were conducted at six Long Term Ecological Research sites within the US including New England the Appalachian Mountains Colorado Michigan Kansas and Arizona While each site has its own unique agricultural history patterns emerge that help make sense of how our actions have affected the earth and how the earth pushes back The book addresses how human activities influence the spatial and temporal structures of agrarian landscapes and how this varies over time and across biogeographic regions It also looks at the ecological and environmental consequences of the resulting structural changes the human responses to these changes and how these responses drive further changes in agrarian landscapes The time frames studied include the ecology of the earth before human interaction pre European human interaction during the rise and fall of agricultural land use and finally the biological and cultural response to the abandonment of farming due to complete abandonment or a land use change such as urbanization

Agricultural transformation in Asia Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, 2021-06-11 Over the past few decades some countries in Asia have been more successful than others in addressing poverty and malnutrition The key question is what policies strategies legislation and institutional arrangements have led to a transformed agricultural sector effectively contributing to poverty alleviation and addressing malnutrition The great majority of national policymakers within and outside the Asia Pacific region are keen to understand the causes of agricultural development and transformation in successful countries in Asia A large number of studies have been conducted and some of them link specific public policies and interventions to successful agricultural transformation However there seems to be lack of focus on the policy legislative and institutional environments that have enabled or impeded agricultural transformation in Asia National policymakers are likely to benefit significantly from adequate and convincing information on successful and relevant experiences in successful transformation Countries are interested in what their neighbours and peers have done and why some have achieved impressive results The main purpose of this study is to take stock of public sector experiences in facilitating and enabling agricultural transformation in selected countries in Asia The study focuses on key public sector interventions in particular policies legislation and institutional innovations because these areas have so far not been adequately researched

Understanding gender dynamics in the context of rural transformation processes Colfer, C.J.P., Ihalainen, M., Monterroso, I., 2020-12-02 This study set out to illustrate and understand how the ongoing processes of rural transformation are influencing women's and men's labor and broader gender relations among the Kenyah It examines the changes that have occurred in two Uma Jalan Kenyah villages in East Kalimantan based on previous longterm ethnographic research beginning in 1979 and continuing periodically until 2004 ending with a Rapid Rural Appraisal visit in 2019 Various

development efforts have altered these peoples environment from dense tropical rainforest in the 1970s through extensive forest loss due successively to logging industrial timber plantations and transmigration Most recently oil palm plantations have flourished over much of the province including the two study communities prompting radical changes to people s agricultural practices Here we examine the implications of these changes for men s and women s lives roles and interactions The most surprising finding is the continuation of comparatively equitable gender dynamics among the Kenyah This is in the face of narratives and policies from education government business and religion with seriously marginalizing gender implications to which the people are increasingly exposed
