$E \in \mathbb{R}^N$ $N = 1, 2$ or 3 and with the values u lying in an open subset G of $\mathbb{R}$ the state space. The state space G arises because physical quantities such as the density or total energy should always be positive thus the values of u are often constrained to an open set G . The flux functions appearing in these balance laws are idealized through prescribed nonlinear functions F mapping G into $\mathbb{R}^N$ while source terms are defined by $S(u, x, t)$ with S a given smooth function of these arguments with values in $\mathbb{R}^m$. In particular the detailed microscopic effects of diffusion and dissipation are ignored. A generalized version of the principle of virtual work is applied see Antman [1]. The formal result of applying the three steps [1]–[3] is that the m physical quantities u define a weak solution of an $m \times m$ system of conservation laws of the form
