In the late summer of 1914, Great Britain anticipated only a brief war. Government and generals alike clung to their faith in traditional methods of supply which inevitably broke down under the appalling demands of the bloody conflict on the Western Front and resulted in the infamous "shell scandal." After a battle in Whitehall that rivaled in ferocity, if not in bloodshed, the one across the channel, David Lloyd George, chief critic of the Defence Department and organizer of cabinet investigations into munitions shortages, became head of the new Ministry of Munitions in May, 1915.

This book is a study of the making of what became the most revolutionary Department of State in British history in that time. Using the vast collection of documents left by the ministry (some only recently made public) as well as other government and private papers, Professor Adams vividly describes the minister's opening up of his new department to "outsiders" from the professions and business — the "men of push and go," as the press called them — and his commitment to a policy of state control of national production. Under the Munitions of War Acts, Lloyd George held unprecedented power over labor, capital, raw materials, and machinery. The result, in the phrase of the day, was that the ministry "delivered the goods" and in so doing set a pattern for the various supply departments established before and during the Second World War.
