paradox at the core of the book To achieve a simulation of languageless reality the author uses a variety of linguistic techniques that uproot meanings break up words and reconstruct terms in novel ways Through deconstruction the metaphoric structure of language is revealed This metaphoric structure is itself approached metaphorically so that the reader begins to sense the trap of a linguistic universe from which there is no escape The book is a literary exercise that simulates the author's poesis experience for the reader Eventually the flood of words on the page begins to go out of focus and dissolve as the reader approaches languagelessness The Poetics of Naming is not for the faint of heart It challenges its readers to move away from the comfortable universe of ordinary language and its meanings and enter a world where the boundaries crumble like digital illusions and limitlessness appears on the horizon of consciousness Poesis is frightening frustrating and Journal of Canadian Poetry ,2003 **Apostrophes VI** E.D.
