Doris Betts:

Faith in Words Ann Weems, Louis Weeks, 2004-01-01 Faith in Words is a timeless collection of essays and poems that reflect on living the life of faith. Vale of Humility George Hovis, 2007 This is an inviting look at the influence of the yeoman's small farm on six modern southern writers. In a deft analysis of works by Doris Betts, Reynolds Price, Fred Chappell, Lee Smith, Clyde Edgerton, and Randall Kenan, Vale of Humility explores the lives of the plain folk, white and black, who populate the worlds of contemporary North Carolina fiction. Hovis explains that a wealthy planter elite was significantly less prominent in North Carolina than in neighboring regions and as such the state's plain folk did not develop a class identity based as deeply in relation to a superior planter class. Instead, the identification of the yeoman's small farm rather than the plantation as necessary to the ideal life has been a distinguishing feature of the state's literature. In this first full-length study of North Carolina's contemporary fiction, Hovis examines the work of six representative writers from the state's three geographic regions: Lee Smith and Fred Chappell from the mountains; Doris Betts and Clyde Edgerton from the Piedmont; and Reynolds Price and Randall Kenan from the coastal plain. The work of these six writers is explored within the broader southern literary tradition with attention to how they have revised such modes as pastoral, family saga, and southwestern humor in order to portray their own regional experiences. Although these writers celebrate the egalitarianism at the heart of the yeoman ideal, they also expose the forms of racism, sexism, and classism that have also marked the state's history.

Southern Strategies Michael Odom, 2024-03-07 A study of how literary strategies illuminate the evangelical foundation of Southern culture. In Southern Strategies: Narrative Negotiation in an Evangelical Region, Michael Odom argues that through the narrative strategies of resistance, satire, and negotiation, a multigenerational group of twentieth-century white Southern writers provides unique insight into the central role evangelical religion has played in shaping the sociopolitical culture of the American South. Odom investigates how W. J. Cash and Lillian Smith confront both the racist culture of their time and the religious institutions that enabled white supremacy to flourish. Insider-outsider Catholic writers Flannery O'Connor and Walker Percy satirize American consumption and the antithetical imperative of evangelical Christianity subsumed within the same culture, and Doris Betts and Dennis Covington engage evangelical religion with curiosity and compassion, redefining spirituality with the aim of providing a sense of community, vision, and selfhood. Southern Strategies concludes with an analysis of contemporary responses to the evangelical activism that animates the base of

Chambers,2012-04-25 Personal Souths a collection of twenty interviews with famous southern writers will mark the fiftieth anniversary of The Southern Quarterly one of the oldest scholarly journals founded in 1962 dedicated to southern studies The figures interviewed range from Erskine Caldwell Eudora Welty and Tennessee Williams all from the 1970s to a virtual Who's Who of southern literature in the second half of the twentieth century All of these interviews were originally published in the journal in the 1980s 1990s and 2000s and are collected here for the first time The South is represented broadly with writers from eight states at least four represent the mountain South Donald Harrington Bobbie Ann Mason Robert Morgan Lee Smith while another four typify a cosmopolitan South Reynolds Price Mary Lee Settle Elizabeth Spencer Tennessee Williams The greatest number of voices at least eight of the authors speak for or from the poor white South Larry Brown Erskine Caldwell Harry Crews Donald Harrington Bobbie Ann Mason Robert Morgan Del Shores Lee Smith Though there is only one African American writer Ernest J Gaines another interview William Styron Pulitzer Prize winning author of The Confessions of Nat Turner also focuses on a conversation about African American literature The interviews are all fascinating Not only do they reveal the personalities of these southern literary stars but they also represent a self-conscious community of writers It is a testament to the quality of The Southern Quarterly that many of these writers when discussing their most important contemporaries often refer to other writers whose interviews are also in this collection These firsthand discussions will continue to illuminate and inform our understanding of their creative work
