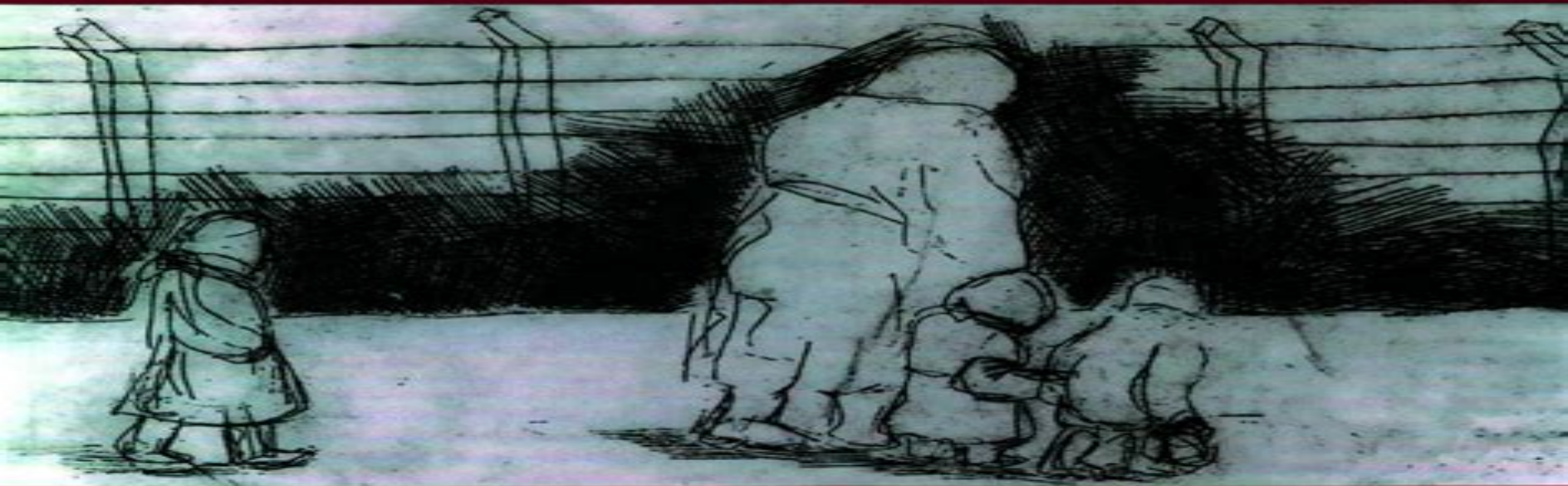

Adler, Katerina Capková, 2020-10-16 Diaries testimonies and memoirs of the Holocaust often include at least as much on the family as on the individual Victims of the Nazi regime experienced oppression and made decisions embedded within families Even after the war sole survivors often described their losses and rebuilt their lives with a distinct focus on family Yet this perspective is lacking in academic analyses In this work scholars from the United States Israel and across Europe bring a variety of backgrounds and disciplines to their study of the Holocaust and its aftermath from the family perspective Drawing on research from Belarus to Great Britain and examining both Jewish and Romani families they demonstrate the importance of recognizing how people continued to function within family units broadly defined throughout the war and afterward

Wartime Rape and Sexual Violence Alana Fangrad, 2013-10-24 Given the extensive body of Holocaust literature it may be surprising to note that there is a distinct gap of reflection analysis and qualification in the area of sexual violence The subject of sexual violence during the Holocaust in particular the sexual violation of Jewish women is a subject that has been largely repressed and silenced Thus this thesis is an attempt to not only rectify the omission of sexual violence from Holocaust history but to bring a level of analysis to this under examined aspect of National Socialism to a point commensurate with that devoted to other aspects of Holocaust studies During the Holocaust sexual violence against Jewish women was both unique and typical It was typical in the forms that sexual violence manifested sexual humiliation rape gang rape sexual slavery but unique in the patterns it followed and the functions it served for the Nazi regime Unlike other genocides sexual violence was not a state sanctioned policy of the Final Solution it was employed in a haphazardly manner that was horrific multi faceted and deadly Perpetrators were motivated by a diversity of factors including a desire for power camaraderie sexual pleasure and masculine ego gratification Moreover sexual violence was multi functional for the Nazi regime operating as a powerful tool of humiliation and dehumanization As the Nazi regime moved into full scale genocide sexual violence became an increasingly integral component to the process of annihilation By dehumanizing Jewish women through varied forms of sexual violence German perpetrators increasingly saw their victims as less than human thereby further removing them from the realm of moral and ethical obligation Sexual violence was clearly an essential component to the continued functioning of genocide because through the process of Jewish womens dehumanization perpetrators were able to more easily continue fulfilling their murderous tasks

Women in the Holocaust Zoë Waxman, 2017 Despite some pioneering work by scholars historians still find it hard to listen to the voices of women in the Holocaust Learning more about the women who both survived and did not survive the Nazi genocide through the testimony of the women themselves not only increases our understanding of this

terrible period in history but makes us rethink our relationship to the gendered nature of knowledge itself Women in the Holocaust is about the ways in which socially and culturally constructed gender roles were placed under extreme pressure yet also about the fact that gender continued to operate as an important arbiter of experience Indeed paradoxically enough the extreme conditions of the Holocaust even of the death camps may have reinforced the importance of gender Whilst Jewish men and women were both sentenced to death gender nevertheless operated as a crucial signifier for survival Pregnant women as well as women accompanied by young children or those deemed incapable of hard labor were sent straight to the gas chambers The very qualities which made them women were manipulated and exploited by the Nazis as a source of dehumanization Moreover women were less likely to survive the camps even if they were not selected for death Gender in the Holocaust therefore became a matter of life and death *The Practice of War* Aparna Rao, Michael

Wolf,2007-07-11 There is an enormous amount of scholarship on the Holocaust and there is a large body of English language sociological research Oddly there is not much overlap between the two fields This text covers both fields **Israel and the Daughters of the Shoah** Ronit Lentin,2000 The murder of a third of Europe s Jews by the Nazis is unquestionably the worst catastrophe in the history of contemporary Judaism and a formative event in the history of Zionism and the State of Israel Understandably therefore the Shoah written about analyzed and given various political interpretations has shaped public discourse in the history of the State of Israel The key element of Shoah in the Israeli context is victimhood and as such it has become a source of shame shrouded in silence and subordinated to the dominant discourse which resulting from the construction of a new Hebrew active subjectivity taught the postwar generation of Israelis to reject diaspora Jewry and its alleged passivity in the face of catastrophe This book is the culmination of years of preoccupation with the meaning of the Shoah for the author an Israeli woman with a split subjectivity that of a daughter of a family of Shoah survivors and that of a daughter of the first Israeli born generation the culmination of her need to break the silence about the Shoah in a society which constructed itself as the Israeli antithesis to diaspora Jewry and to excavate a truth from underneath the mountain of Zionist nation building myths These myths the author argues not only had deep implication for the formation of her generation but also a profound impact on the Israeli Palestinian conflict Moreover they are shot through with images of the masculine Israeli contrasted with those of the weak passive non virile Jewish Other of the diaspora This book offers the first gendered analysis of Israeli society and the Shoah The author employs personal narratives of nine Israeli daughters of Shoah survivors writers and film makers and a feminist re reading of official and unofficial Israeli and Zionist discourses to explore the ways in which the relationship between Israel and the Shoah has been gendered in that the Shoah was feminized while Israel was masculinized This new perspective has considerable implications for the analysis of Israeli society a gendered analysis of Israeli construction of nation reveals how the Shoah and Shoah discourse are exploited to justify Israel s i e the new Hebrew s self perceived right of occupation Israel thus not only negated the Jewish diaspora but also stigmatized and feminized Shoah victims and survivors all the while employing Shoah discourses as an excuse for occupation both in the past and in the present **International Handbook of Violence Research**

Concomitantly there is the possibility of becoming pregnant Then there is the birth of the babies For some the very sight of the babies and children reminds mothers of the horrific violations they suffered When mothers harbor deep seated hatred or distain for such children it results in more misery The hatred may be so great that children born of rape leave home early in order to fend for themselves on the street This seventh volume in the Genocide series will provoke debate discussion reflection and ultimately action The issues presented include ongoing mass rape of girls and women during periods of war and genocide ostracism of female victims terrible psychological and physical wounds the plight of offspring resulting from rapes and the critical need for medical and psychological services

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
