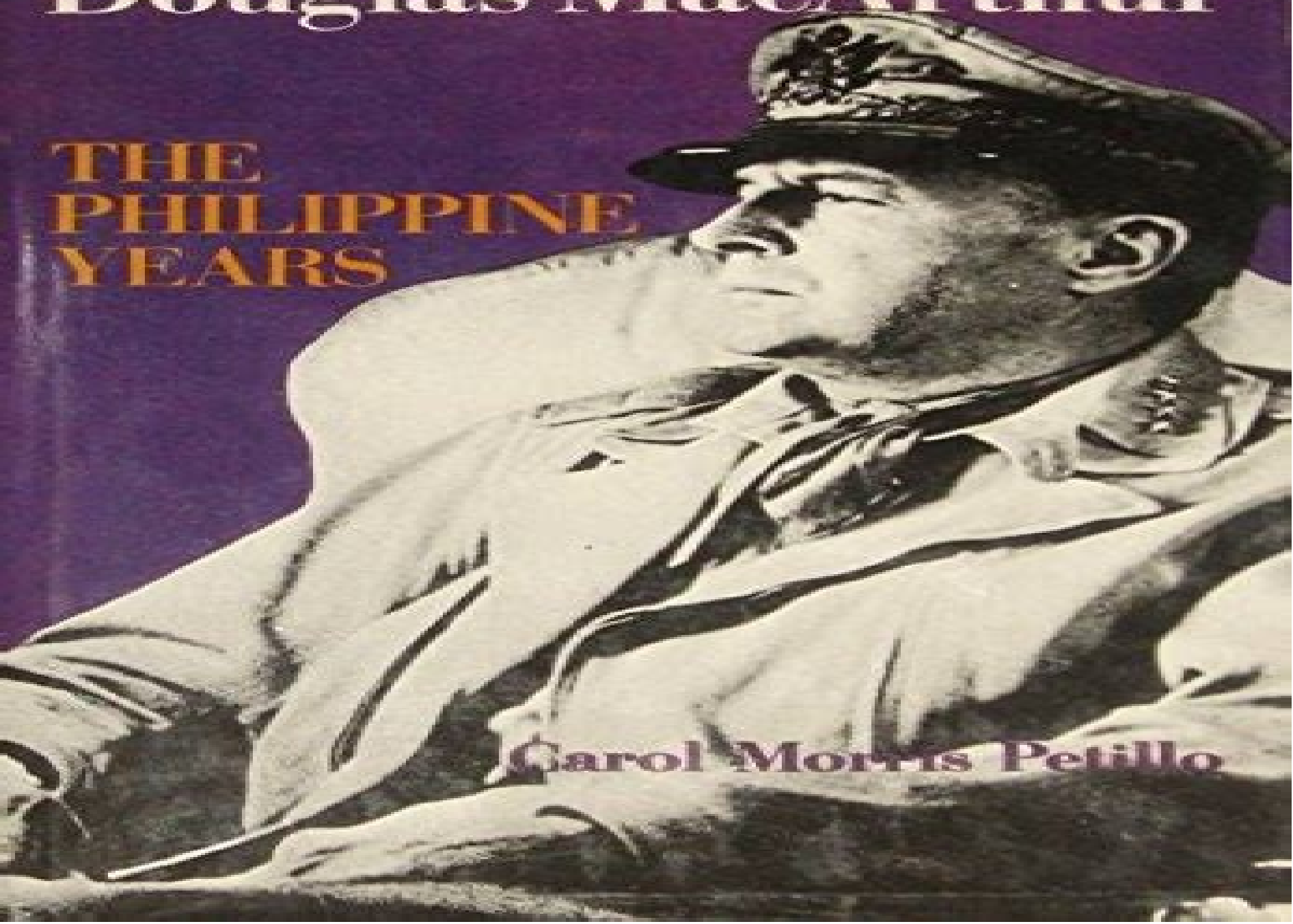

Leary, 2001-01-01 General Douglas MacArthur has been hailed as the greatest soldier in American history While not everyone would agree with that assessment there is no question that MacArthur played a prominent role in the emergence of the United States as a world power in the twentieth century A distinguished combat soldier during World War I and an innovative educator at West Point in the 1920s MacArthur became the army's chief of staff during the Great Depression He went abroad in the 1930s to prepare the Philippines for war His stand against the Japanese following Pearl Harbor made him a national hero and his subsequent campaign against Japanese forces in the Southwest Pacific only added to his reputation The Korean War gave MacArthur a final opportunity to display his military skills MacArthur and the American Century assembles for the first time a nuanced and full scrutiny of MacArthur's entire career Essays by such experts as Stanley L Falk and D Clayton James accompany materials by Dwight D Eisenhower and MacArthur himself providing analysis and evaluation of the immense impact this dramatic figure had on war peace and the American imagination Philippine-American Military History, 1902-1942 Richard B. Meixsel, 2015-10-02 Military obligations rested lightly upon the Filipino people for much of the period that America occupied the Philippines but Filipinos could enlist in the United States Army and Navy attend the service academies at West Point and Annapolis or join military organizations restricted to duty in the islands such as the Philippine Scouts Philippine Constabulary Philippine National Guard and the navy's insular force In the 1930s the Philippine government established its own armed forces Throughout much of this time the U S army also kept a substantial portion of its troop strength in the Philippines This annotated bibliography of nearly 700 titles highlights the extent and variety of the Philippine American military experience from the conquest of the islands by the United States in 1902 to the defeat of Philippine and American forces by the Japanese in 1942 The bibliography includes memoirs and biographies of Filipino and American officers and enlisted men from MacArthur to Ferdinand Marcos unit histories army post and navy base histories medals and insignia books and the most extensive list of prisoner of war memoirs yet published Annotations address controversies such as the widely disparate estimates of American deaths on the Bataan Death March and include previously unpublished information such as casualty figures for American and Philippine forces in 1941 1942 **MacArthur in Asia** Hiroshi Masuda, 2012-10-05 General Douglas MacArthur's storied career is inextricably linked to Asia His father Arthur served as Military Governor of the Philippines while Douglas was a student at West Point and the younger MacArthur would serve several tours of duty in that country over the next four decades becoming friends with several influential Filipinos including the country's future president Emanuel L Quezon In 1935 he became Quezon's military advisor a post he held after retiring from the U S Army and at the time of Japan's invasion of 1941 As Supreme Commander for the Southwest Pacific MacArthur led American forces throughout the Pacific War He officially accepted Japan's surrender in 1945 and would later

oversee the Allied occupation of Japan from 1945 to 1951. He then led the UN Command in the Korean War from 1950 to 1951 until he was dismissed from his post by President Truman. In MacArthur in Asia, the distinguished Japanese historian Hiroshi Masuda offers a new perspective on the American icon, focusing on his experiences in the Philippines, Japan, and Korea, and highlighting the importance of the general's staff, the famous Bataan Boys, who served alongside MacArthur throughout the Asian arc of his career, to both MacArthur's and the region's history. Before they became legends, these young officers served their country in posts from Washington, D.C. to Panama, from West Point to war-torn China. and skeletal forces Beyond these professional challenges they endured shattering personal tragedies the sudden deaths of children or spouses divorce depression and court martial Yet when the world faced possibly its darkest hour as fascism and barbarism were on the march they stood ready to lead America s young men in the fight for civilization By the end of World War II even German commanders expressed amazement at the dynamic change in American military leadership since the Great War *Generals in the Making* is the first comprehensive history of America s World War II generals between the wars an invaluable prequel to every history of that war

Imparato, 2000 The two year search for General Douglas MacArthur s speeches and reports was truly a labor of love My Administrative Assistant Ellen Schaefer and I culled over 1 000 sources including memories biographies histories military magazines such as the *Army* and *Air Force Journals* unit histories commercial magazines and newspapers Magazines included such publications as *National Geographic* *Life Magazine* and many esoteric less circulated literature such as *Military Magazine* *Retired Officers Magazine* *Air Force Magazine* and so many others We received guidance and assistance from such sources as the U S Military Academy the Engineering School at Ft Leavenworth the Command and General Staff School at Leavenworth the Army War College the MacArthur Archives Director James Zobel the Library of Congress the War Department the sources seemed endless We do believe we were able to capture all the major public speeches and reports covering MacArthur s truly productive years from 1908 through 1964 Contains more than 125 speeches reports It will be interesting to note MacArthur established his personality early in his military career and never veered from this His admonition from his Mother when MacArthur was a student at West Point was never cheat never lie never tattle Adhering to this edict MacArthur offered to resign from the Academy rather than answer questions from the Academy panel investigating hazing and harassment by a group of fellow students MacArthur continued to develop his hard line against political and military intrigue by resolving to always do what he believed right even if he knew no one was watching Further he was determined never to refuse to carryout the order of a senior officer never be insubordinate to constituted authority
