Australia having emigrated there in 1915 Hugh Lofting was educated at Mount St Mary's College in Spinkhill Derbyshire. From 1905 to 1906 he studied abroad studying civil engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in the US. He travelled widely as a civil engineer before enlisting in the Irish Guards regiment of the British Army to serve in the First World War.
