Stribling: an Intense Friendship Alice Davis Wood, 2008-10-21 This is primarily the story of the long time friendship between Dorothea Dix and Dr Stribling as told by them in their unedited letters The letters are preceded by summaries of their life experiences at the time their friendship began Dix was the most politically active and well traveled woman her time She enlarged or founded thirty two mental hospitals in fifteen states and other countries fifteen schools for the feeble minded a school for the blind and several training schools for nurses Dix successfully petitioned Congress to create the Government Hospital for the Insane in Washington D C Dix petitioned Congress in 1854 to sell twelve million acres of public land whose proceeds would befit the insane blind and paupers throughout the nation After it was passed by Congress but then vetoed by Congress a devastated Dix too ill to work traveled to England to recuperate By the late 60s Western State and similar institutions were filled with incurable patients leaving little room for those who could be cured By 1871 only eight of Striblings patients were expected to be cured twenty six others were doubtful and the remaining three hundred and six patients were decidedly unfavorable The situation was depressing for Stribling his staff and the caretakers who constantly drew on their skills energies and goodness of heart to soothe patients depressed spirits and replace their delusions with pleasant thoughts It would have been far easier to restore curable patients who would be in the hospital only for the brief duration of their illness Stribling died in 1974 Because of his crusade to cure the insane in the South he had been one of the most influential Virginians of his time Dix continued her crusade until the Civil war when she became head of the Union nurses Afterwards she resumed her efforts to help those who could not help themselves Dix died on July 17 1887 at the New Jersey State Hospital at Trenton **Criminalizing the Seriously Mentally Ill** Edwin Fuller Torrey, Joan Stieber, Jonathan Ezekiel, 1998-04 Dorothea Dix Amy Paulson Herstek, 2001 Traces the life and career of a great social reformer from her strict upbringing through her years as a teacher and Civil War nurse to her work as a lobbyist Words that Make New Jersey History Howard L. received an appointment as clerk in the Patent Office at a salary of 1400 a year She was one of the first and believed herself to have been the very first of women appointed to a regular position in one of the departments with work and wages equal to that of a man Then came the catastrophe of the Civil War Early on she decided that marriage would not be the direction of her life She didn t just throw herself into her battlefield work she reinvented how it should be done She operated independently from Dorothea Dix and the corps of army nursing She went where the shells were flying After the war she worked tirelessly to find out the fate of missing soldiers From the beginning of the year 1865 to the end of 1868 she sent out 63 182 letters of inquiry But her crowning achievement was not the fame she gained and the company of the powerful She fought tooth and nail against an isolationist United States to gain acceptance of the Treaty of Geneva which helped her found the American Red Cross Nearly to the end of her long life she worked in the field often at the cost of her own health But she was no shrinking violet She knew how to fight quietly and plied her inflexible will upon the causes that mattered most to her the Red Cross abolition of slavery women s rights and relief of suffering There has probably not been a better biography of Barton than this two volume set by William Barton published in 1922 For the first time both volumes are together in a well formatted ebook version Every memoir of the American Civil War provides us with another view of the catastrophe that changed the country forever Be sure to LOOK INSIDE by clicking the cover above or download a sample to Welfare State, 6th Edition Walter I.
