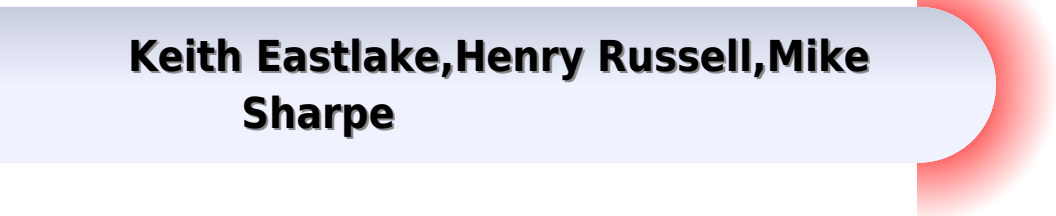

Airships, Cardington Geoffrey Chamberlain, 1984-01 Udviklingen af britiske luftskibe set i relation til de tyske Zeppelinere R 101 s katastrofale forlis belyses Det f rste Battle of Britain *His Majesty's Airship* S C Gwynne, 2024-05-21 The tragic story of the British airship R101 which went down in a spectacular hydrogen fueled fireball in 1930 killing more people than died in the Hindenburg disaster seven years later has been largely forgotten In His Majesty s Airship historian S C Gwynne resurrects it in vivid detail telling the epic story of great ambition gone terribly wrong Airships those airborne leviathans that occupied center stage in the world in the first half of the twentieth century were a symbol of the future R101 was not just the largest aircraft ever to have flown and the product of the world s most advanced engineering she was also the lynchpin of an imperial British scheme to link by air the far flung areas of its empire from Australia to India South Africa Canada Egypt and Singapore No one had ever conceived of anything like this R101 captivated the world There was just one problem beyond the hype and technological wonders these big steel framed hydrogen filled airships were a dangerously bad idea Gwynne s chronicle features a cast of remarkable and often tragically flawed characters including Lord Christopher Thomson the man who dreamed up the Imperial Airship Scheme and then relentlessly pushed R101 to her destruction Princess Marthe Bibesco the celebrated writer and glamorous socialite with whom he had a long affair and Herbert Scott a national hero who had made the first double crossing of the Atlantic in any aircraft in 1919 eight years before Lindbergh s famous flight but who devolved into drink and ruin These historical figures and the ship they built flew and crashed come together in a grand tale that details the rocky road to commercial aviation written by one of the best popular historians writing today **British Airship Bases of the Twentieth Century** Malcolm Fife, 2017-05-17 Numerous books have been written on airships but few concentrate on their bases and infrastructure to support their operations **British Airship Bases of the Twentieth Century** starts with documenting the primitive facilities from which the early machines flew in the years prior to the First World War The outbreak of the First World War resulted in airships being adopted for military purposes and bases were established across Britain Most of these were operated by the Royal Naval Air Service for the protection of shipping against U boats In the 1920s an attempt was made by the British Government to build airships for commercial transport The locations where these giants of the sky were constructed are described as well as the proposed overseas passenger terminals The latter part of this enthralling and detailed book chronicles the attempt to establish the airship as a means of transport to link together the far flung lands of the British Empire Reference is also made at attempts to revive the airship in the closing decade of the 20th century and the locations associated with them Illustrations 170 black and white photographs **Airships in International Affairs 1890 - 1940** J. Boulton Paul Aircraft Since 1915 Alec Brew, 2020-05-29 The ancient Norwich firm of Boulton Paul were brought into aircraft construction in 1915 and quickly became one of the great innovators They pioneered metal construction and built the frame of the largest aircraft ever built in Britain the R 101 airship The Overstrand the last of their superlative medium bombers was the first aircraft in the world to feature a power operated gun turret and after their move to Wolverhampton in 1936 and

change of name to Boulton Paul Aircraft their gun turrets became a vital component of the war effort not least in their own Defiant which fought in the Battle of Britain and was the most successful night fighter in the dark nights of the Blitz Their post war Balliol trainer was the World's first single engine turboprop and their last production aircraft because the technology of their gun turrets was translated into their world lead as manufacturers of power operated control units and then fly by wire Becoming part of the Dowty Group and later GE Aviation their advanced aerospace product line is now invested in the firm of Moog still in Wolverhampton still innovating
