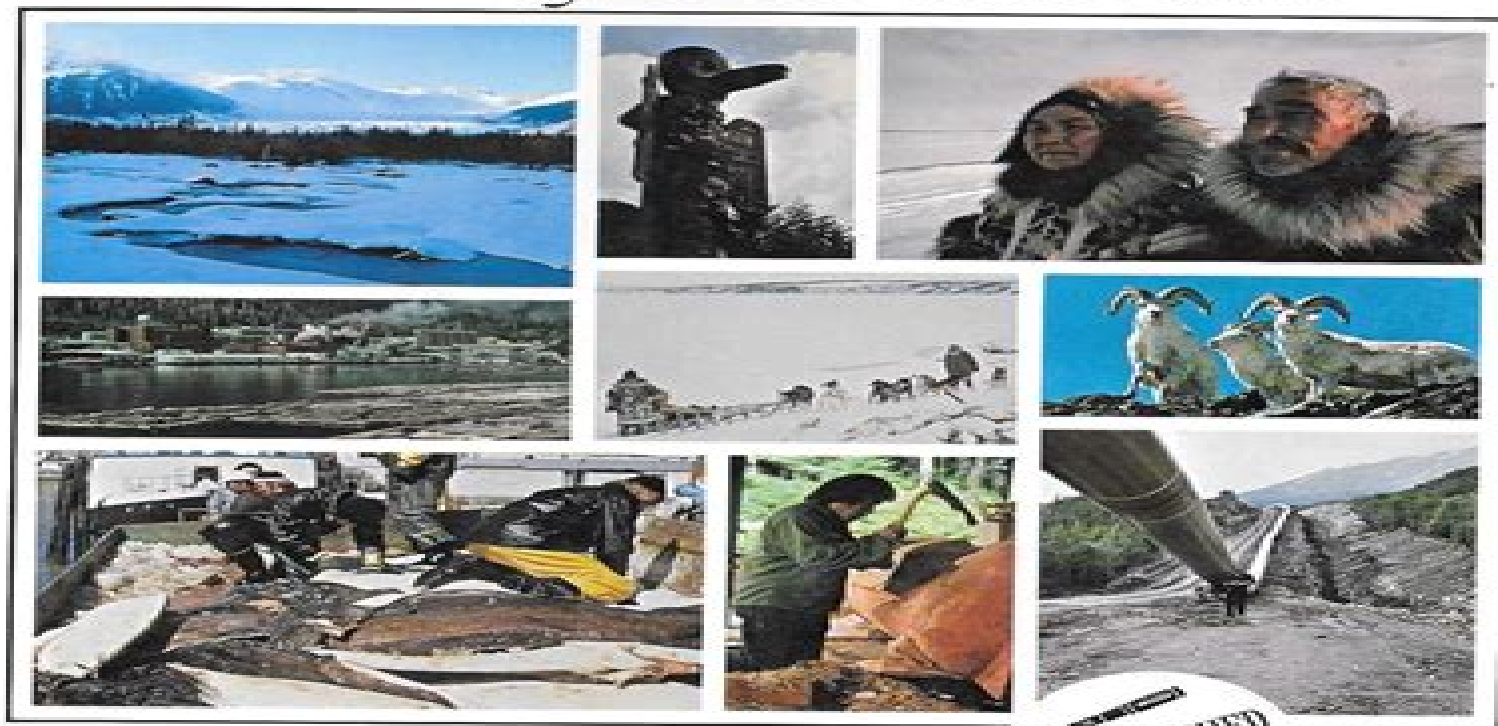

Nielson, Ph.D., 2018-02-01 As a unique distant geographical region of the United States Alaska has evolved from military insignificance to high strategic priority in the 142 years since its purchase from Russia in 1867 The reasons for this dramatic shift derive from a correlation of geography foreign policy domestic politics and military technology Historically the role of the armed forces in Alaska has been large and diverse Alaska was one of the two principal territorial purchases made by the United States between 1803 and 1867 adding nearly 1 5 million square miles to America s national domain Smaller by the size of Texas than Jefferson s Louisiana Purchase Alaska unlike all of the territories and states carved out of the former languished in obscurity and isolation and was administered as a colonial dependency by the military and other branches of the federal government its official territorial status and government notwithstanding While sharing many common aspects of frontier settlement and Western history with territories such as Montana the Dakotas Wyoming and Colorado Alaska presented special challenges peculiar to a non contiguous arctic and sub Arctic environment separated from the United States by a foreign power Indeed only the defeated South under Reconstruction experienced the same degree of military occupation and martial law Alaska also has the unique distinction in the American experience of belonging to Imperial Russia before it became of interest to American expansionists Still others found Alaska tempting and pursued their own designs North of 53 The Spanish British Canadians and even the French plied Alaska s waters and made their claims to Alyeska the Great Land And it is with these clashing imperial ambitions that this three volume history begins *An Alaska Anthology* Stephen W. Haycox, Mary Childers Mangusso, 2011-06-01 Alaska with its Indian Eskimo and Aleut heritage its century of Russian colonization its peoples formidable struggles to wrest a living or a fortune from the North s isolated and harsh environment and its relatively recent achievement of statehood has long captured the popular imagination In *An Alaska Anthology* twenty five contemporary scholars explore the region s pivotal events significant themes and major players Native Russian Canadian and American The essays chosen for this anthology represent the very best writing on Alaska giving great depth to our understanding and appreciation of its history from the days of Russian American Company domination to the more recent threat of nuclear testing by the Atomic Energy Commission and the influence of oil money on inexperienced politicians Readers may be familiar with an earlier anthology *Interpreting Alaska s History* from which the present volume evolved to accommodate an

Hanable, 1992 **The Human Face of the Alaska Gold Rush** Steve Levi, 2021-01-01 It is the land of the Alaska Gold Rush where nuggets were said to be the size of goose eggs where men froze to death in search of the elusive yellow metal and dancehall girls lured overnight millionaire sourdoughs into marriage Honky tonk pianos punctuated the howl of the north wind in towns that were half tent and half ramshackle collections of driftwood whalebone and packing cases It was a time of whiskey and gold and long lonely trails behind a dogsled It was in a word ALASKA In cities rugged men and women walked on planks set across streets so deep with spring mud horses could be swallowed On the tundra life was a living hell with mosquitoes gnats white socks and biting flies descending in clouds on warm blooded creatures On the flip side of the season temperature could drop to 50 or 60 degrees below zero cold enough to freeze a can of oil so solid it could be cut in half with a saw With wind blasting at 100 miles an hour the chill factor could go down to 100 degrees below zero cold enough to freeze a person to death in a matter of minutes if he could not find proper shelter In whiteout conditions visibility could diminish to a foot in a matter of minutes It was in a word ALASKA **Battleground Alaska** Stephen Haycox, 2016-04-08 No American state is more antistatist than Alaska And no state takes in more federal money per capita which accounts for a full third of Alaska's economy This seeming paradox underlies the story Stephen Haycox tells in *Battleground Alaska* a history of the fraught dynamic between development and environmental regulation in a state aptly dubbed The Last Frontier Examining inconvenient truths the book investigates the genesis and persistence of the oft heard claim that Congress has trampled Alaska's sovereignty with its management of the state's pristine wilderness At the same time it debunks the myth of an inviolable Alaska statehood compact at the center of this claim Unique isolated and remote Alaska's economy depends as much on absentee corporate exploitation of its natural resources particularly oil as it does on federal spending This dependency forces Alaskans to endorse any economic development in the state putting them in conflict with restrictive environmental constraint *Battleground Alaska* reveals how Alaskans abiding resentment of federal regulation and control has exacerbated the tensions and political sparring between these camps and how Alaska's leaders have exploited this antistatist sentiment to promote their own agendas specifically the opening of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge to oil drilling Haycox builds his history and critique around four now classic environmental battles in modern Alaska the establishment of the ANWR in the 1950s the construction of the Trans Alaska Pipeline in the 1970s the passage of the Alaska National Interests Lands Conservation Act in 1980 and the struggle that culminated in the Tongass Timber Reform Act of 1990 What emerges is a complex tale with no clear cut villains and heroes that explains why Alaskans as a collective almost always opt for development even as they profess their genuine love for the beauty and bounty of their state's environment Yet even as it

exposes the potential folly of this practice Haycox's work reminds environmentalists that all wilderness is inhabited and that human life depends as it always has on the exploitation of the earth's resources

Ehrlander, 2017-10 2018 Alaskana Award from the Alaska Library Association 2018 Alaska Historical Society James H Drucker Alaska Historian of the Year Award Walter Harper Alaska Native Son illuminates the life of the remarkable Irish Athabascan man who was the first person to summit Mount Denali North America's tallest mountain Born in 1893 Walter Harper was the youngest child of Jenny Albert and the legendary gold prospector Arthur Harper His parents separated shortly after his birth and his mother raised Walter in the Athabascan tradition speaking her Koyukon Athabascan language When Walter was seventeen years old Episcopal archdeacon Hudson Stuck hired the skilled and charismatic youth as his riverboat pilot and winter trail guide During the following years as the two traveled among Interior Alaska's Episcopal missions they developed a father son like bond and summited Denali together in 1913 Walter's strong Athabascan identity allowed him to remain grounded in his birth culture as his Western education expanded and he became a leader and a bridge between Alaska Native peoples and Westerners in the Alaska territory He planned to become a medical missionary in Interior Alaska but his life was cut short at the age of twenty five in the Princess Sophia disaster of 1918 near Skagway Alaska Harper exemplified resilience during an era when rapid socioeconomic and cultural change was wreaking havoc in Alaska Native villages Today he stands equally as an exemplar of Athabascan manhood and healthy acculturation to Western lifeways whose life will resonate with today's readers

Empire's Edge Preston Jones, 2007 In 1898 Nome Alaska burst into the American consciousness when one of the largest gold strikes in the world occurred on its shores Over the next ten years Nome's population exploded as both men and women came north to seek their fortunes Closer to Siberia than to New York Nome's citizens created their own version of small town America on the northern frontier Less than 150 miles from the Arctic Circle they weathered the Great War and the diphtheria epidemic of 1925 as well as floods fires and the Great Depression They enlivened the Alaska winters with pastimes such as high school basketball and social clubs *Empire's Edge* is the story of how ordinary Americans made a life on the edge of a continent a life both ordinary and extraordinary *The Teacher and the Superintendent* George E. Boulter II, Barbara Grigor-Taylor, 2015-12-03 From its inception in 1885 the Alaska School Service was charged with the assimilation of Alaskan Native children into mainstream American values and ways of life Working in the missions and schools along the Yukon River were George E Boulter and Alice Green his future wife Boulter a Londoner originally drawn to the Klondike had begun teaching in 1905 and by 1910 had been promoted to superintendent of schools for the Upper Yukon District In 1907 Green left a comfortable family life in New Orleans to answer the call to serve in the Episcopal mission boarding schools for Native children at Anvik and Nenana where she occupied the position of government teacher As school superintendent Boulter wrote frequently to his superiors in Seattle and Washington DC to discuss numerous administrative matters and to report on problems and conditions overall From 1906 to 1918 Green kept a personal journal hitherto in private possession in which she

reflected on her professional duties and her domestic life in Alaska Collected in The Teacher and the Superintendent are Boulter s letters and Green s diary Together their vivid first hand impressions bespeak the earnest but paternalistic beliefs of those who lived and worked in immensely isolated regions seeking to bring Christianity and civilized values to the Native children in their care Beyond shedding private light on the missionary spirit however Boulter and Green have also left us an invaluable account of the daily conflicts that occurred between church and government and of the many injustices suffered by the Native population in the face of the misguided efforts of both institutions Alaska Roads Historic Overview ,2015

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
