school was started chores and responsibilities were shared by everyone Alcatraz became home and American Indians of all tribes became a family But the occupation lasted two years and Oakes who had become its spokesman left after his stepdaughter's death on the island Memoranda from the White House recommended doing anything to turn the public against the occupation so it could be ended Water and electricity were cut off reports of conflict on the island began appearing in the press and suspicious fires burned five buildings Nevertheless the occupation of Alcatraz remains what historian Vine Deloria Jr has called perhaps the most significant Indian action since the Little Bighorn
