Colonialism on the Prairies Blanca Tovias, 2012-07-23 This book spans a century in the history of the Blackfoot First Nations of present day Montana and Alberta It maps out specific ways in which Blackfoot culture persisted amid the drastic transformations of colonisation with its concomitant forced assimilation in both Canada and the United States It portrays the strategies and tactics adopted by the Blackfoot in order to navigate political cultural and social change during the hard transition from traditional life ways to life on reserves and reservations Cultural continuity is the thread that binds the four case studies presented encompassing Blackfoot sacred beliefs and ritual dress practices the transmission of knowledge and the relationship between oral stories and contemporary fiction Blackfoot voices emerge forcefully from the extensive array of primary and secondary sources consulted resulting in an inclusive history wherein Blackfoot and non Blackfoot scholarship enter into dialogue Blanca Tovias combines historical research with literary criticism a strategy that is justified by the interrelationship between Blackfoot history and the stories from their oral tradition Chapters devoted to examining cultural continuity discuss the ways in which oral stories continue to inspire contemporary Native American fiction This interdisciplinary study is a celebration of Blackfoot culture and knowledge that seeks to revalorise the past by documenting Blackfoot resistance and persistence across a wide spectrum of cultural practice The volume is essential reading for all scholars working in the fields of Native American studies colonial and postcolonial history ethnology and literature

Museums, Heritage and Indigenous Voice Bryony Onciul, 2015-07-03 Current discourse on Indigenous engagement in museum studies is often dominated by curatorial and academic perspectives in which community voice viewpoints and reflections on their collaborations can be under represented This book provides a unique look at Indigenous perspectives on museum community engagement and the process of self representation specifically how the First Nations Elders of the Blackfoot Confederacy have worked with museums and heritage sites in Alberta Canada to represent their own culture and history Situated in a post colonial context the case study sites are places of contention a politicized environment that highlights commonly hidden issues and naturalized inequalities built into current approaches to community engagement Data from participant observation archives and in depth interviewing with participants brings Blackfoot community voice into the text and provides an alternative understanding of self and cross cultural representation Focusing on the experiences of museum professionals and Blackfoot Elders who have worked with a number of museums and heritage sites Indigenous Voices in Cultural Institutions unpicks the power and politics of engagement on a micro level and how it can be applied more broadly by exposing the limits and challenges of cross cultural engagement and community self representation The result is a volume that provides readers with an in depth understanding of the nuances of self representation and decolonization

Missionaries Among Miners, Migrants & Blackfoot Leonard Van Tighem, Mary Eggermont-Molenaar, Victor Van Tighem, 2007 Using valuable primary source material most of which is previously unpublished and some of which has been translated from the Flemish Dutch and French editors Mary Eggermont Molenaar and Paul Callens introduce the Van Tighem brothers to today's reader *Missionaries Among Miners Migrants and Blackfoot The Vantighem Brothers Diaries Alberta 1875 1917* contains the transcribed diaries of brothers Leonard and Victor Van Tighem Belgian Catholic missionaries in Alberta between 1874 and 1917 Leonard an Oblate priest served in a number of parishes in southern Alberta some of which he helped establish Victor a member of the Belgian Van Dale congregation served on the Peigan and Blood reserves in the southern part of the province Their diaries are interspersed with letters from family and friends and letters and articles by contemporary bishops and fellow priests and lay brothers The Van Tighems diaries offer a fascinating glimpse of life during Alberta's early settlement and growth the immigration boom the development of Lethbridge and the Peigan reserve railroads the mining industry and the impact of World War I are all part of the historical backdrop of the brothers diaries

Epic Adventures Jan Jansen, Hendrik M. J. Conaty, 2015-03-01 In 1990 Gerald Conaty was hired as senior curator of ethnology at the Glenbow Museum with the particular mandate of improving the museum s relationship with Aboriginal communities That same year the Glenbow had taken its first tentative steps toward repatriation by returning sacred objects to First Nations peoples These efforts drew harsh criticism from members of the provincial government Was it not the museum s primary legal ethical and fiduciary

responsibility to ensure the physical preservation of its collections Would the return of a sacred bundle to ceremonial use not alter and diminish its historical worth and its value to the larger society Undaunted by such criticism Conaty oversaw the return of more than fifty medicine bundles to Blackfoot and Cree communities between the years of 1990 and 2000 at which time the First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Act FNSCORA still the only repatriation legislation in Canada was passed Repatriation he wrote is a vital component in the creation of an equitable diverse and respectful society We Are Coming Home is the story of the highly complex process of repatriation as described by those intimately involved in the work notably the Piikani Siksika and Kainai elders who provided essential oversight and guidance We also hear from the Glenbow Museum s president and CEO at the time and from an archaeologist then employed at the Provincial Museum of Alberta who provides an insider s view of the drafting of FNSCORA These accounts are framed by Conaty s reflections on the impact of museums on First Nations on the history and culture of the Niitsitapi or Blackfoot and on the path forward With Conaty s passing in August of 2013 this book is also a tribute to his enduring relationships with the Blackfoot to his rich and exemplary career and to his commitment to innovation and mindful museum practice
