other business ventures His fathers business was one Cornell desired but his older brother Emile was to inherit the business from Gustav Cornell was apprentinced to a tailor Cornell and Wilma immigrated to America at different times around 1901 They met and married in Philadelphia While in Philadelphia and during the roaring twenties they operated a delicatessen Pauline grew up with two brothers Erwin and Louis Pauline enjoyed an especially fond relationship with her brother Louis as they danced for fun and competition and enjoyed the same friends Wilma left for Europe leaving Cornell behind with her two boys to help Cornell in the store While Wilma was in Europe Cornell sold the store and took a job as an insurance salesman When Wilma returned from Europe she was understandably upset and took Cornell to task for selling the store Later Cornell purchased a gasoline service station and Pauline spent late hours with her father as he kept the store open late Pauline grew into a young woman She attended Temple University and majored in art While Pauline was in Europe Creston Smith ran away from an orphanage near Lancaster Pa He and his sister Edna had been placed in the orphanage because his father had recently died Creston was a frail youngster born prematurely and sickly Pauline and Creston met after a baseball practice in Philadelphia For months after they became acquainted Pauline pretended to only speak German This made it hard for Creston who finally found out the truth They were married in 1935 Raising a family was hard and work was harsh The family grew to five with one boy and two girls They moved frequently over America as Creston sought work during the depression Creston found work in the San Francisco ship yards building amphibious landing Craft during World War Two Louis was drafted into the Army and served in the African campaign under General Patton He fought against Rommel and was part of the invasion of Sicily in 1943 He was killed in fighting at Gala Bay Sicily July 10 1943 Pauline Creston and their family moved from California to Philadelphia to be with Wilma Cornell was bed ridden with arthritis The family was together again now and Wilma was able to relate the stories of the old country to her grandchildren The spirit of Tvarozna as a family home drew the family together even though they didnt live in Eastern Europe anymore **Schedule 2** United States.
