Subcommittee on Department of the Interior and Related Agencies,1986 A Mirror in the Roadway Morris Dickstein,2021-08-10 In a famous passage in *The Red and the Black* the French writer Stendhal described the novel as a mirror being carried along a roadway In the twentieth century this was derided as a naive notion of realism Instead modern writers experimented with creative forms of invention and dislocation Deconstructive theorists went even further questioning whether literature had any real reference to a world outside its own language while traditional historians challenged whether novels gave a trustworthy representation of history and society In this book Morris Dickstein reinterprets Stendhal's metaphor and tracks the different

worlds of a wide array of twentieth century writers from realists like Theodore Dreiser Sinclair Lewis Edith Wharton and Willa Cather through modernists like Franz Kafka and Samuel Beckett to wildly inventive postwar writers like Saul Bellow Günter Grass Mary McCarthy George Orwell Philip Roth and Gabriel García Márquez Dickstein argues that fiction will always yield rich insight into its subject and that literature can also be a form of historical understanding Writers refract the world through their forms and sensibilities He shows how the work of these writers recaptures yet also transforms the life around them the world inside them and the universe of language and feeling they share with their readers Through lively and incisive essays directed to general readers as well as students of literature Dickstein redefines the literary landscape a landscape in which reading has for decades been devalued by society and distorted by theory Having begun with a reconsideration of realism the book concludes with several essays probing the strengths and limitations of a historical approach to literature and criticism

Abadie, 1999 Although he belonged to an American generation of writers deeply influenced by the high modernist revolt against nature and against the self-imposed limits of realism to a palpable world William Faulkner reveals throughout his work an abiding sensitivity to the natural world He writes of the big woods of animals and of the human body as a ground of being that art and culture can neither transcend nor completely control The eleven essays that make up this volume including a paper written by the acclaimed novelist William Kennedy explore the place of the unbuilt world in Faulkner's fiction They give particular attention to the social mythic and economic significance

imaginaries and disciplinary transmigrations that gesture towards a university of tomorrow As theorists posit new futures and call for an end to historically grounded or discipline based so called silo approaches to knowledges a de facto reorganization of disciplinary boundaries and a migratory spirit have spontaneously infused the humanities with new life These transmigrations instead of diffusing the disciplinary terrain have strengthened and broadened existing fields They are provoking re mappings of intellectual topography and ironically have brought about more rather than less integration Activated by such massive cultural shifts as the turn from print to visual culture the technological revolution and its virtual sublimates the acceleration of scientific advances the rise and incorporation of mass or popular culture and the possibilities of replication the humanities are producing integrated knowledges what we are calling new TechKnowledgies that interface the humanities the arts the social and hard sciences with digital technologies and research emerging at the borders of all these fields

The Irish Voice in America Charles Fanning, In this study Charles Fanning has written the first general account of the origins and development of a literary tradition among American writers of Irish birth or background who have explored the Irish immigrant or ethnic experience in works of fiction The result is a portrait of the evolving fictional self consciousness of an immigrant group over a span of 250 years Fanning traces the roots of Irish American writing back to the eighteenth century and carries it forward through the traumatic years of the Famine to the present time with an intensely productive period in the twentieth century beginning with James T Farrell Later writers treated in depth include Edwin O Connor Elizabeth Cullinan Maureen Howard and William Kennedy Along the way he places in the historical record many all but forgotten writers including the prolific Mary Ann Sadlier *The Irish Voice in America* is not only a highly readable contribution to American literary history but also a valuable reference to many writers and their works For this second edition Fanning has added a chapter that covers the fiction of the past decade He argues that contemporary writers continue to draw on Ireland as a source and are important chroniclers of the modern American experience

Masterplots Frank Northen Magill, Laurence W. Mazzeno, 1996 Entries are arranged alphabetically by title with the type of work author type and time of plot locale first publication date and principal characters listed A plot synopsis is followed by a critical essay and a brief bibliography Each entry is three to four pages in length The four indexes included are by chronological date by geographic locale by title and by author The title *Masterplots* does not convey the depth of information contained in the 12 volumes The titles treated range chronologically from antiquity to the early 1990s with the major emphasis on literature of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries While the majority of the entries are British European and United States fiction the work also encompasses drama works or collections of poetry and nonfiction Am Ref Books Annu 1997
