Don Nice John Paul Driscoll,2004 Published in conjunction with the exhibition Don Nice Hudson river paintings 1966 2004 held at the Albany Institute of History and Art June 19 Aug 22 2004 Historic Real Estate Whitney Martinko,2020-05-15 A detailed study of early historical preservation efforts between the 1780s and the 1850s In *Historic Real Estate* Whitney Martinko shows how Americans in the fledgling United States pointed to evidence of the past in the world around them and debated whether and how to preserve historic structures as permanent features of the new nation s landscape From Indigenous mounds in the Ohio Valley to Independence Hall in Philadelphia from Benjamin Franklin s childhood home in Boston to St Philip s Episcopal Church in Charleston South Carolina from Dutch colonial manors of the Hudson Valley to Henry Clay s Kentucky estate early advocates of preservation strove not only to place boundaries on competitive real estate markets but also to determine what should not be for sale how consumers should behave and how certain types of labor should be valued Before historic preservation existed as we know it today many Americans articulated eclectic and sometimes contradictory definitions of architectural preservation to work out practical strategies for defining the relationship between public good and private profit In arguing for the preservation of houses of worship and Indigenous earthworks for example some invoked the public interest of their stewards to strengthen corporate control of these collective spaces Meanwhile businessmen and political partisans adopted preservation of commercial sites to create opportunities for and limits on individual profit in a growing marketplace of goods And owners of old houses and ancestral estates developed methods of preservation to reconcile competing demands for the seclusion of and access to American homes to shape the ways that capitalism affected family economies In these ways individuals harnessed preservation to garner political economic and social profit from the performance of public service Ultimately Martinko argues by portraying the problems of the real estate market as social rather than economic advocates of preservation affirmed a capitalist system of land development by promising to make it moral *Paul Cushman* Albany Institute of History and Art,2007-01-01 The life time and work of a renowned Albany potter comes vividly to life in these pages Paul Cushman 1767 1833 is recognized today as one of the founders of a regional stoneware industry that stretched throughout the Upper Hudson Valley of New York State When Cushman moved to Albany around 1800 local stoneware production was limited to a few potters His decision to open a pottery works half a mile west of the Albany Goal at the beginning of the new century resulted in a long lived and successful business It also initiated a century of tremendous growth and expansion in regional stoneware manufacturing The expert contributors to this volume reveal all that is currently known about the life and work of Paul Cushman and place his business and pottery within broad and useful historical and aesthetic frameworks **An American Collection** Amon Carter Museum of Western Art,Patricia A. Junker,2001 Amon G Carter 1879 1955 is one of the legendary men of Texas history Born in a log cabin he was self made becoming Fort Worth s leading citizen and champion He developed an interest in the art of Frederic

Costello, 2021-12-03 George Washington was an affluent slave owner who believed that republicanism and social hierarchy were vital to the young country s survival And yet he remains largely free of the elitist label affixed to his contemporaries as Washington evolved in public memory during the nineteenth century into a man of the common people the father of democracy This memory we learn in *The Property of the Nation* was a deliberately constructed image shaped and reshaped over time generally in service of one cause or another Matthew R Costello traces this process through the story of Washington s tomb whose history and popularity reflect the building of a memory of America s first president of by and for the American people Washington s resting place at his beloved Mount Vernon estate was at times as contested as his iconic image and in Costello s telling the many attempts to move the first president s bodily remains offer greater insight to the issue of memory and hero worship in early America While describing the efforts of politicians business owners artists and storytellers to define influence and profit from the memory of Washington at Mount Vernon this book s main focus is the memory making process that took place among American citizens As public access to the tomb increased over time more and more ordinary Americans were drawn to Mount Vernon and their participation in this nationalistic ritual helped further democratize Washington in the popular imagination Shifting our attention from official days of commemoration and publicly orchestrated events to spontaneous visits by citizens Costello s book clearly demonstrates in compelling detail how the memory of George Washington slowly but surely became *The Property of the Nation*

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
