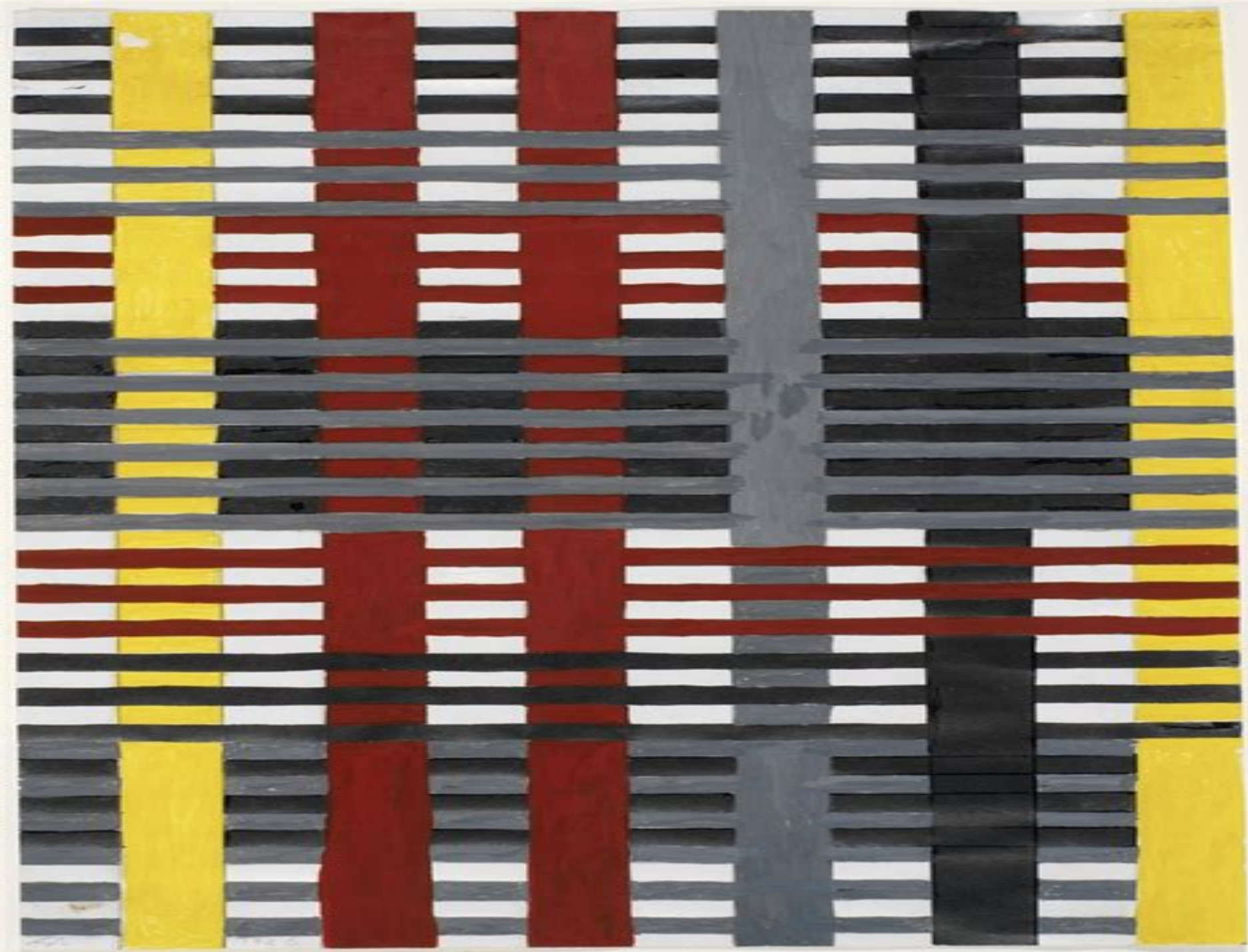

Albers and Morandi: Never Finished Josef Albers, Giorgio Morandi, Laura Mattioli, 2021-11-16 An unprecedented catalogue exploring the formal and visual affinities and contrasts between Josef Albers and Giorgio Morandi two of modern art's greatest painters Rarely seen together the artworks of Josef Albers 1888 1976 and Giorgio Morandi 1890 1964 share many similarities Although they never met both artists worked in series as they explored difference and potential through their distinctive treatment of color shape form and morphology They were also both influenced by Cezanne As master illusionists and experts in proportion they tackled similar conceits from different perspectives Albers focused on the effects of subtle or bold changes and interactions in color while Morandi made still lifes that treat simple objects as a cast of characters on a stage exploring their relationship in space Published on the occasion of the critically acclaimed exhibition Albers and Morandi Never Finished at David Zwirner New York in 2021 the book illuminates the visual conversation between these two artists With the exhibition hailed by The New Yorker's Peter Schjeldahl as one of the best I've ever seen this publication brings this unusual thought provoking pairing to your home Gorgeous reproductions are accompanied by a roundtable about form and color between the exhibition's curator David Leiber Heinz Liesbrock the director of the Josef Albers Museum Quadrat Bottrop and Nicholas Fox Weber the executive director of The Josef and Anni Albers Foundation as well as an essay by Laura Mattioli the Morandi expert and founder of the Center for Italian Modern Art

Ad Reinhardt Ad Reinhardt, Josef-Albers-Museum, 2011 The paintings of the American artist Ad Reinhardt were from the start defined by their clear geometrical forms Reinhardt who before his training as a painter had received a degree in art history rejected any kind of fusion between art and life or any mystification of painting Around 1953 he did his first black paintings in which every tendency to colour seemed to fade From 1960 his paintings were all only black which he himself

informa company **Color Chart** Ann Temkin, 2008 Color Chart celebrates a paradox the lush beauty that results when contemporary artists assign colour decisions to chance readymade source or arbitrary system Midway through the 20th century long held convictions regarding the spiritual truth or scientific validity of particular colours gave way to an excitement about colour as a mass produced and standardized commercial product The Romantic quest for personal expression instead became Andy Warhol's I want to be a machine the artistry of mixing pigments was eclipsed by Frank Stella's Straight out of the can it can't get better than that This book and the exhibition it accompanies is the first devoted to this pivotal transformation and features work by some forty artists ranging from Ellsworth Kelly and Gerhard Richter to Sherrie Levine and Damien Hirst *Josef Albers* Josef Albers, Paul Overby, South Bank Centre, 1994 A sumptuously produced introduction to the ideas and methods of one of the most influential artists and theorists of the twentieth century First issued in 1972 as a limited edition set of prints Formulation Articulation is being published in book form for the first time Josef Albers drew on over forty years work in a variety of media woodcuts sandblasted glass pictures and oil paintings for these poetic explorations of color and form Created just four years before his death in 1976 the images can be seen as the summation of Albers's creative life Albers was a student and a teacher at the Bauhaus from 1920 to 1933 escaped to America and taught at Black Mountain College until 1949 and was chairman of the Department of Design at Yale University until 1958 As both artist and teacher he influenced innumerable artists including Mark Rothko Barnett Newman and Robert Rauschenberg Albers's seminal text Interaction of Color 1963 which was translated into eight languages affected art teaching all over the world This book embodies all the elements of Albers's lifetime preoccupation with abstraction color and perception He draws the viewer into a dynamic relationship with his work showing how color can have deceptive and unpredictable effects depending on how it interacts with other colors The order of the 127 illustrations was carefully chosen by Albers so that they can be examined and appreciated for their visual interaction or as beautiful works of art in their own right They appear alone on the page in pairs or sometimes four together The accompanying text includes key passages from Albers's own writings printed on special foldout sections and the introduction by noted critic T G Rosenthal includes comparative and contextual illustrations 150 illustrations 127 in color **Theories and Documents of Contemporary Art** Kristine Stiles, 1996 Enth u a S 74 Concrete art 1936 49 Max Bill S 74 77 The mathematical approach in contemporary art 1949 Max Bill S 301 304 Dieter Roth *Josef Albers: No Tricks, No Twinkling of the Eyes* Tone Hansen, Milena Hoegsberg, 2014 Josef Albers no tricks no twinkling of the eyes presents a reading of Albers practice through the lens of contemporary artists writers and art historians who negotiate the relevance of both his educational and artistic legacy today Selections of Albers own writing are dispersed throughout the book offering a rich glance into his dedication to pedagogy and art and the pioneering ideas that still resonate with contemporary art practitioners Richly illustrated the publication spans Albers production over sixty years and highlight the dexterity of Albers practice and not least his commitment to
