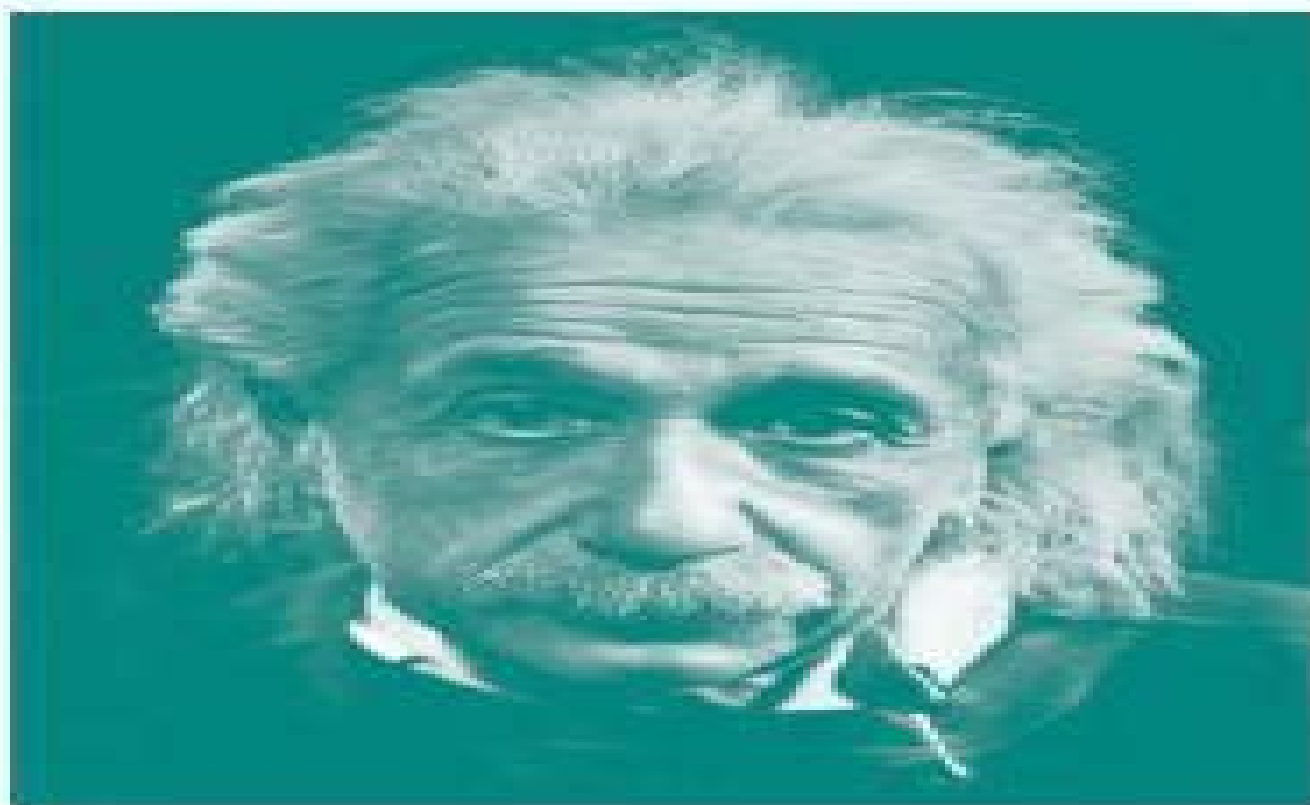

The Conscious Universe Menas Kafatos, Robert Nadeau, 2012-12-06 This discussion resulted from a dialogue which began some seven years ago between a physicist who specializes in astrophysics general relativity and the foundations of quantum theory and a student of cultural history who had done post doctoral work in the history and philosophy of science Both of us at that time were awaiting the results of some experiments being conducted under the direction of the physicist Alain Aspect at the University of Paris South The experiments were the last in a series designed to test some predictions based on a mathematical theorem published in 1964 by John Bell There was no expectation that the results of these experiments would provide the basis for developing new technologies The questions which the experiments were designed to answer concerned the relationship between physical reality and physical theory in the branch of physics known as quantum mechanics Like most questions raised by physicists which lead to startling new insights they were disarmingly simple and direct Is quantum physics asked Bell a self consistent theory whose predictions would hold in a new class of experiments or would the results
