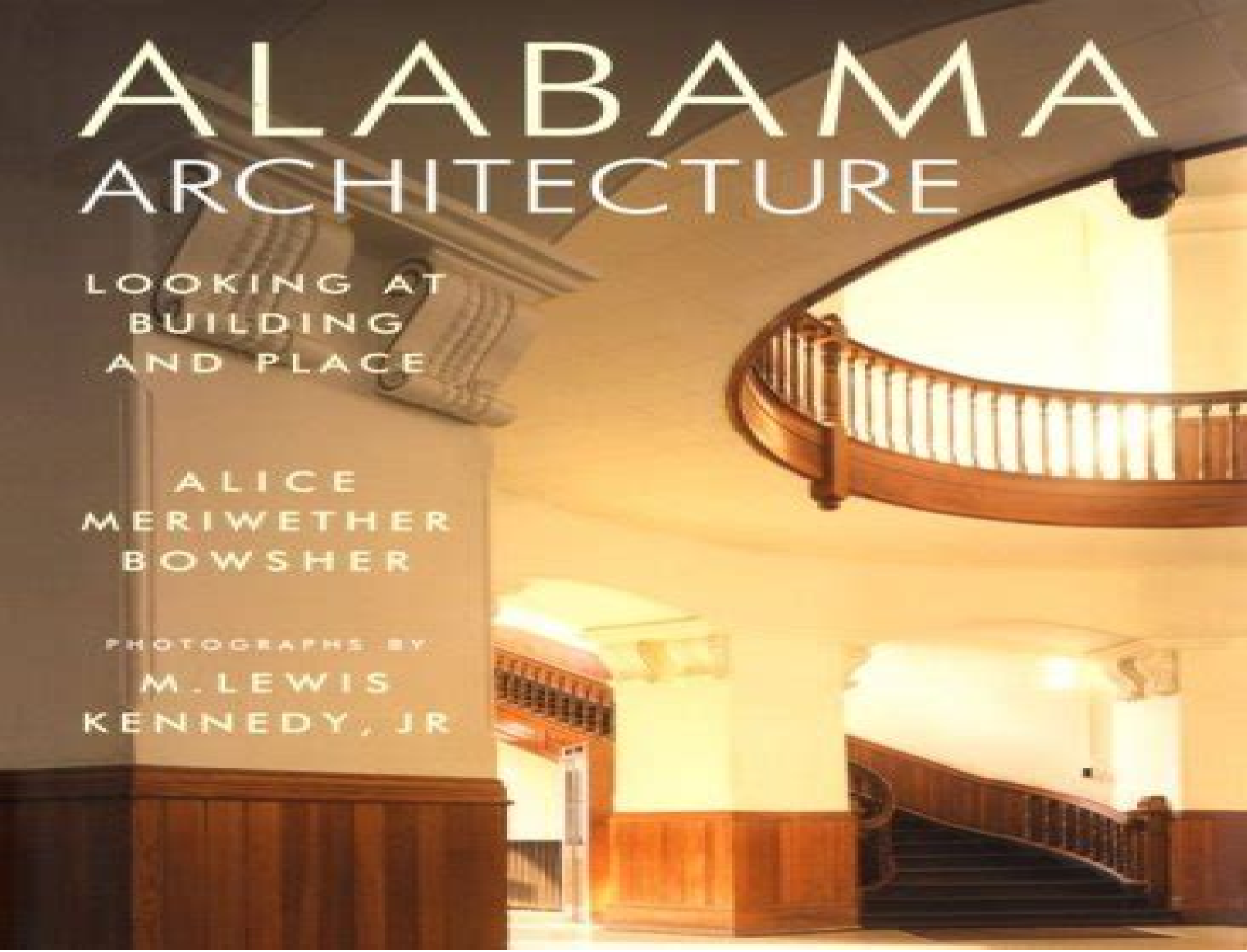

Researching African American Genealogy in Alabama Frazine Taylor, 2008-05-01 Over the past two decades in workshops and personal consultations thousands of persons have received the expertise and knowledge of author Frazine Taylor about Alabama genealogical research In addition she has taught the art to hundreds of students As Dr James Rose notes all genealogists looking for the family tree in Alabama sooner or later come across Frazine And now they have her book *Researching African American Genealogy in Alabama A Resource Guide* In the book she provides the information and guidance to help locate the resources available for researching African American records in archives libraries and county courthouses throughout the state The idea for this guidebook rose out of her lecturing throughout the country and having noticed that reference guides on African American family history resources seemed to exist for every state except Alabama This was regrettable not merely for researchers on African American history in Alabama In fact Alabama's records play an especially important role in U S family history research because of the migration patterns of Alabama's freedmen first to urban areas of Alabama and then to northern cities a trend that continued throughout the first part of the twentieth century

E40° Jack Williams, 2006 The Appalachian mountain chain once contained the highest and most dramatic mountains on earth Worn down over time these mountains still hold some of the most diverse climactic zones and singular geological formations in existence In *East 40 Degrees An Interpretive Atlas* Jack Williams examines a succession of beautiful but little known towns along this cordillera a term descended from the Latin *chorda* meaning braided rope revealing in their layers of history and geography how both their diverse cultural and social circumstances and their geological history were instrumental in forming each town's distinctive character Referring to the spatial orientation of the Appalachian mountain chain the east 40 degrees of the title runs from Alabama through fifteen states to the coast of Maine Each town Williams examines sits within the folds of these mountains or beside a river nourished in their moist uplands Beginning his record with the continental collisions that shaped each town's history more than 300 million years ago Williams allows us to see the tenuous web of connections between ourselves and the natural processes that shape this earth Featuring a wealth of beautiful and significant illustrations and maps this unique work brings into focus the critical issues of environmental and cultural sustainability confronting us today Elegant poetic and erudite *East 40 Degrees* will appeal to architects and landscape architects planners environmental historians ecologists geographers and anyone interested in the history and origins of our modern landscapes and towns Publication of this volume was assisted by a grant from Furthermore a program of the J M Kaplan Fund *Bibliographic Guide to Art and Architecture* New York Public Library. Hall,2016-09-01 Although he was a native of Bullock County Alabama Wade Hall teacher writer poet critic interviewer folklorist and documentarian spent most of his fifty year career in Kentucky But he was never emotionally far from his home as evidenced by his passion for collecting vintage Alabama postcards In his lifetime he amassed 10 000 which he then graciously gave to the University of Alabama Libraries and Troy University in a large joint bequest that also included rare books quilts folk art letters and more These postcards date from the late 1800s to the mid 20th century and offer a fascinating and diverse picture of the state The meaning of postcards that could be purchased as a travel souvenir is largely forgotten today when cameras are commonplace But the value of Hall s stunning collection cannot be missed The some 400 cards featured in Greetings from Alabama are revealing of scenes familiar and rare From Birmingham s Vulcan to Mobile s Bellingsrath Gardens from Enterprise s boll weevil monument to Huntsville s rockets from Helen Keller s home to William Rufus King s resting place the scenes offer captivating glimpses of Alabama history

Breisch,2003 Although vernacular architecture scholarship has expanded beyond its core fascination with common buildings and places its attention remains fixed on the social function of building Consistent with this expansion of interests Constructing Image Identity and Place includes essays on a wide variety of American building types and landscapes drawn from a broad geographic and chronological spectrum Subjects range from examinations of the houses hotels and churches of America s colonial and Republican elite to analyses of the humble cottages of Southern sharecroppers and mill workers Mississippi juke joints and the ephemeral rustic arbors and bowers erected by Civil War soldiers Other contributors examine
