Alan Rawsthorne Alan Rawsthorne, **Alan Rawsthorne** John McCabe, 1999 This is the first comprehensive study of the life and music of Alan Rawsthorne 1905-71 one of the leading British composers of the twentieth century Rawsthorne came from the same generation of composers as Britten Walton Tippett and Constant Lambert Since his death in 1971 his music after a period of comparative neglect is currently enjoying a revival in performance and recording The composer and pianist John McCabe here brings a lifetime's knowledge of the man and his music to a vivid portrait of Rawsthorne's life drawing on conversations with his family friends and colleagues as well as contemporary documentation Almost every one of his works is discussed many of them in detail demonstrating the versatility and range of Rawsthorne's vision from popular works such as *Street Corner* and the piano concertos to the remarkable power of his lesser known later works In particular McCabe draws attention to the astonishing renewal of Rawsthorne's creative energy during his later period and the immense broadening of his emotional and technical horizons leading to such masterpieces as the *Third Symphony* and *Carmen Vitale* He makes a powerful case for a thorough reassessment of Rawsthorne's oeuvre A complimentary CD provides the reader with a representative sample of Rawsthorne's music Please note customers are required to send away for the accompanying CD

Dressler, 2004-09-30 Alan Rawsthorne was a British composer film scorer music editor author and radio talk show presenter At the heart of his musical contribution was a unique blend of European and English 20th century techniques which concentrated on instrumental rather than vocal music While most of this volume is dedicated to Rawsthorne's original musical works the reader's attention is also drawn to his articles radio talks and arrangements of works of other composers His disposition placed his career in the background of others who were more public his preference was to write music for its own sake rather than for notoriety and monetary gain Through the guiding direction of other composers and radio leadership personnel Rawsthorne created music for the next age as much as for his current time This bibliography is comprised of a listing of all known works completed and uncompleted premieres and selected other performances highlighting venues dates and performers names a discography of both commercially available discs and archival tapes and discs a 1500 item annotated set of citations of reviews sections of books articles and the like regarding the works Rawsthorne's life and recordings five appendices song cycle and multi section works components alphabetical works list Manchester manuscript collection details chronological works list works of other composers dedicated to Rawsthorne and a 25 page index to the book

Words and Music Peter Dickinson,2016 Articles tributes and reminiscences of composer pianist and author Peter Dickinson are here brought together for the first time Peter Dickinson made an enduring contribution to British musical life and his music has been regularly performed and recorded by leading musicians His writings brought together here for the first time are equally noteworthy Covering well over half a century the subjects are fascinatingly varied Apart from musical interests ranging from Charles Ives to John Cage they touch on literature and Dickinson s meetings with W H Auden and Philip Larkin are an intriguing insight that led to his Auden songs and the chamber work Larkin s Jazz American themes are prominent in this collection There are unique reviews of concert life in New York from 1959 to 1961 an account of the teaching programme at the Juilliard School of Music at that time three studies of Ives and features containing original material on Copland Thomson and Cage all of whom Dickinson knew Features on Erik Satie include the imaginary discussion marking his centenary in 1966 Dickinson also writes about his own music providing an insight into what it was like being a British composer in the later twentieth century Peter Dickinson was born in Lancashire in 1934 and lived in Suffolk until his passing His 80th birthday was marked by a whole variety of tributes including concerts articles broadcasts and various interviews some included in this book PETER DICKINSON was a British composer and pianist as well as author and editor of Boydell URP books on Berkeley Copland Cage Barber and Berners As a pianist Dickinson had a twenty five year international partnership with his sister the mezzo Meriel Dickinson for whom he wrote song cycles to poems of E E Cummings Gregory Corso and Stevie Smith He was a regular contributor to BBC Radio 3 and was widely read as a critic on the Gramophone He was an Emeritus Professor of the Universities of Keele and London and was chair of the Bernarr Rainbow Trust for which he
