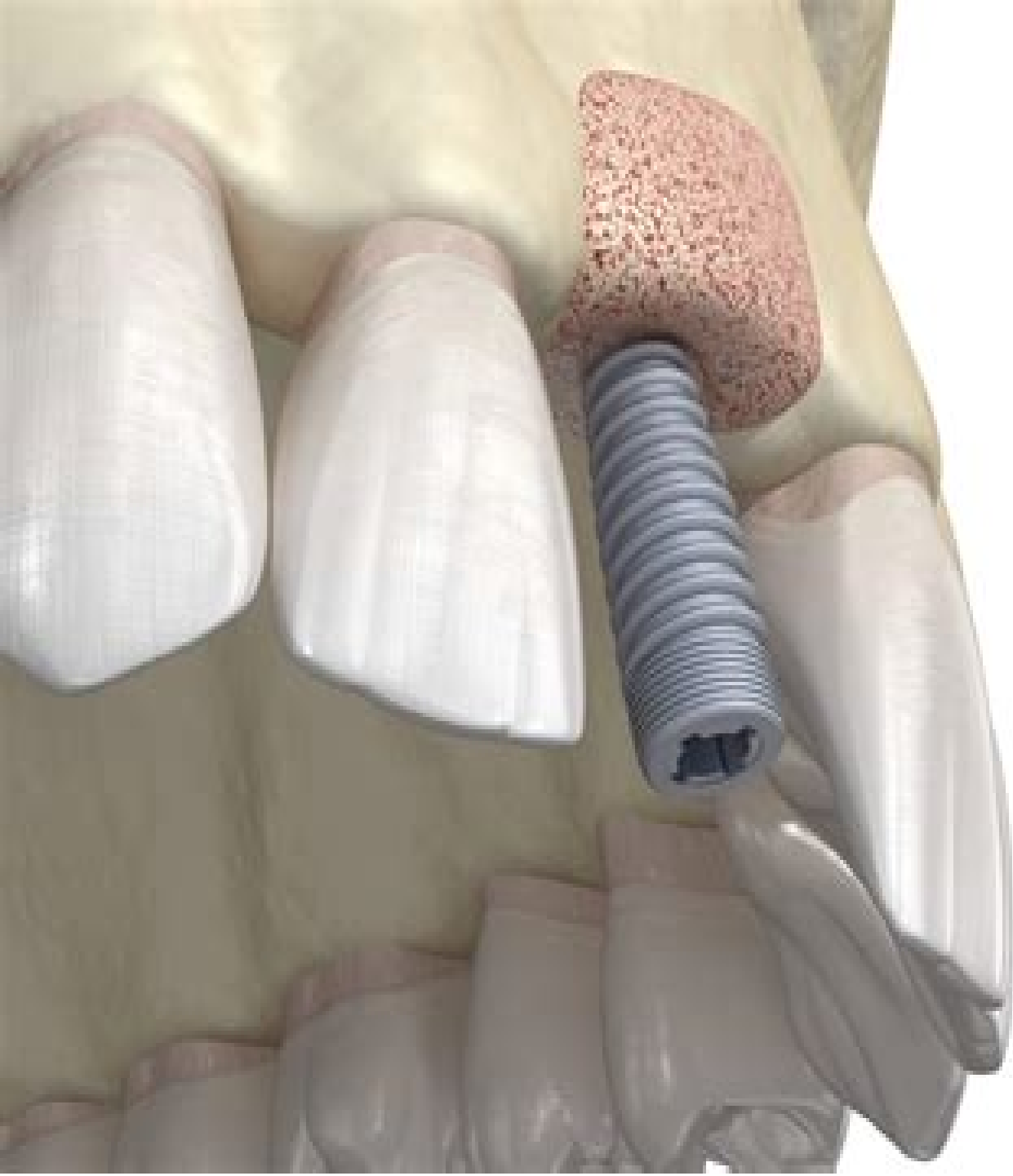

mechanisms of implant incorporation and loosening will be presented All new data concerning materials and methods for incorporation enhancement will be critically analyzed Data useful for clinical application will be stressed Orthopaedic Surgeons will find information which will improve their clinical practice and basic scientists will be helped to understand and appreciate clinical needs
