Creating America Jan Cohn, 2010-11-23 Before movies radio and television challenged the hegemony of the printed word the Saturday Evening Post was the preeminent vehicle of mass culture in the United States And to the extent that a mass medium can be the expression of a single individual this magazine with a peak circulation of almost three million copies a week was the expression of its editor George Horace Lorimer Cohn shows how Lorimer made the Post into a uniquely powerful magazine that both celebrated and helped form the values of the time *Creating America's Future* James T. Temkin,1998-09-01 Isaac Mayer Wise 1819 1900 founder of the major institutions of Reform Judaism in America was a man of his time a pioneer in a pioneer's world When he came to America from his childhood Bohemia in 1846 he found fewer than 50 000 Jews and only two ordained rabbis With his sense of mission and tireless energy he set himself to tailoring the vehicle of Reform Judaism to meet the needs of the growing Jewish community Wise strove for unity among American Jews and for a college to train rabbis to serve them The establishment of Hebrew Union College 1875 was the crowning achievement of his life His quest for unity also led him to draw up an American Jewish prayer book Minhag America to found the Central Conference of American Rabbis and to edit two weeklies their editorials breathing fire and energy were no less important in his quest for leadership Here as elsewhere it was his persistence that won him the war where his impetuosity lost him many battles Professor Temkin's writing captures the vigour of Wise's personality and the politics and concerns of contemporary Jewish life and leadership in America Based primarily on material in the American Jewish Archives of the Hebrew Union College this biography is a lively portrait of a rabbi whose singular efforts in many fields made him a pivotal figure in the naturalization of the Jew and Judaism in the New World The book was first published in hardback in 1992 under the title Isaac Mayer Wise Shaping American Judaism Create America Vernon Weaver,2022-10-25 You will find that Create

Turner,Jason Edward Black,2022-05-17 Collection of essays that reassesses history as rhetoric and rhetorical history as practice **How the Post Office Created America** Winifred Gallagher,2016-06-28 A masterful history of a long underappreciated institution How the Post Office Created America examines the surprising role of the postal service in our nation s political social economic and physical development The founders established the post office before they had even signed the Declaration of Independence and for a very long time it was the U S government s largest and most important endeavor indeed it was the government for most citizens This was no conventional mail network but the central nervous system of the new body politic designed to bind thirteen quarrelsome colonies into the United States by delivering news about public affairs to every citizen a radical idea that appalled Europe s great powers America s uniquely democratic post powerfully shaped its lively argumentative culture of uncensored ideas and opinions and made it the world s information and communications superpower with astonishing speed Winifred Gallagher presents the history of the post office as America s own story told from a fresh perspective over more than two centuries The mandate to deliver the mail then the media imposed the federal footprint on vast often contested parts of the continent and transformed a wilderness into a social landscape of post roads and villages centered on post offices The post was the catalyst of the nation s transportation grid from the stagecoach lines to the airlines and the lifeline of the great migration from the Atlantic to the Pacific It enabled America to shift from an agrarian to an industrial economy and to develop the publishing industry the consumer culture and the political party system Still one of the country s two major civilian employers the post was the first to hire women African Americans and other minorities for positions in public life Starved by two world wars and the Great Depression confronted with the country s increasingly anti institutional mind set and struggling with its doubled mail volume the post stumbled badly in the turbulent 1960s Distracted by the ensuing modernization of its traditional services however it failed to transition from paper mail to email which prescient observers saw as its logical next step Now the post office is at a crossroads Before

deciding its future Americans should understand what this grand yet overlooked institution has accomplished since 1775 and consider what it should and could contribute in the twenty first century Gallagher argues that now more than ever before the imperiled post office deserves this effort because just as the founders anticipated it created forward looking communication oriented idea driven America

The Girl on the Magazine Cover Carolyn Kitch, 2009-11-15 From the Gibson Girl to the flapper from the vamp to the New Woman Carolyn Kitch traces mass media images of women to their historical roots on magazine covers unveiling the origins of gender stereotypes in early twentieth century American culture Kitch examines the years from 1895 to 1930 as a time when the first wave of feminism intersected with the rise of new technologies and media for the reproduction and dissemination of visual images Access to suffrage higher education the professions and contraception broadened women s opportunities but the images found on magazine covers emphasized the role of women as consumers suffrage was reduced to spending sexuality to sexiness and a collective women s movement to individual choices of personal style In the 1920s Kitch argues the political prominence of the New Woman dissipated but her visual image pervaded print media With seventy five photographs of cover art by the era s most popular illustrators The Girl on the Magazine Cover shows how these images created a visual vocabulary for understanding femininity and masculinity as well as class status Through this iconic process magazines helped set cultural norms for women for men and for what it meant to be an American Kitch contends

Circulating Jim Crow Adam McKible, 2024-02-20 Winner 2023 2024 RSAP Book Prize Research Society for American Periodicals In the early twentieth century the Saturday Evening Post was perhaps the most popular and influential magazine in the United States establishing literary reputations and shaping American culture In the popular imagination it is best remembered for Norman Rockwell s covers which nostalgically depicted a wholesome and idyllic American way of life But beneath those covers lurked a more troubling reality Under the direction of its longtime editor George Horace Lorimer the magazine helped justify racism and white supremacy It published works by white authors that made heavy use of paternalistic tropes and demeaning humor portraying Jim Crow segregation and violence as simple common sense Circulating Jim Crow demonstrates how the Post used stereotypical dialect fiction to promulgate white supremacist ideology and dismiss Black achievements citizenship and humanity Adam McKible tells the

story of Lorimer's rise to prominence and examines the white authors who provided the editor and his readers with the caricatures they craved. He also explores how Black writers of the Harlem Renaissance pushed back against the Post and its commodified racism. McKible places the erstwhile household names who wrote for the magazine in conversation with figures such as Paul Laurence Dunbar, F. Scott Fitzgerald, Ann Petry, W. E. B. Du Bois, and William Faulkner. Revealing the role of the Saturday Evening Post in normalizing racism for millions of readers, this book also offers a new understanding of how Black writers challenged Jim Crow ideology.
