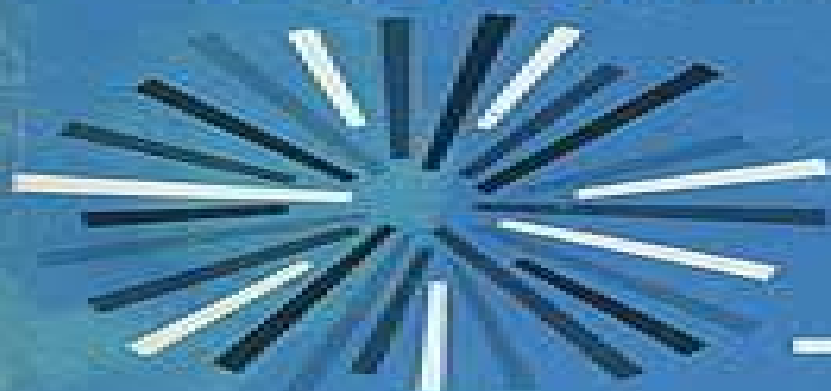

This challenges the traditional ideas of intentions as existing solely in the minds of individuals and formulates a new conceptual framework for examining if and when intentions influence the interpretation of meaning.
