Dreaming Southern A Novel:

Trauma, Memory, and Narrative in the Contemporary South African Novel, 2012-01-01 The contributions to this volume probe the complex relationship of trauma memory and narrative By looking at the South African situation through the lens of trauma they make clear how the psychic deformations and injuries left behind by racism and colonialism cannot be mended by material reparation or by simply reversing economic and political power structures Western trauma theories as developed by scholars such as Caruth van der Kolk Herman and others are insufficient for analysing the more complex situation in a postcolony such as South Africa This is because Western trauma concepts focus on the individual traumatized by a single identifiable event that causes PTSD Post Traumatic Stress Disorder What we need is an understanding of trauma that sees it not only as a result of an identifiable event but also as the consequence of an historical condition in the case of South Africa that of colonialism and more specifically of apartheid For most black and coloured South Africans the structural violence of apartheid's laws were the existential condition under which they had to exist The living conditions in the townships pass laws relocation and racial segregation affected great parts of the South African population and were responsible for the collective traumatization of several generations This trauma however is not an unclaimed and unclaimable experience Postcolonial thinkers who have been reflecting on the experience of violence and trauma in a colonial context writing from within a Fanonian tradition have on the contrary believed in the importance of reclaiming the past and of transcending mechanisms of victimization and resentment so typical of traumatized consciousnesses Narration and the novel have a decisive role to play here

Chicken Dreaming Corn Roy Hoffman, 2011-01-15 In 1916 on the immigrant blocks of the Southern port city of Mobile Alabama a Romanian Jewish shopkeeper Morris Kleinman is sweeping his walk in preparation for the Confederate veterans parade about to pass by Daddy his son asks are we Rebels Today muses Morris Yes we are Rebels Thus opens a novel set like many in a languid Southern town But in a rarity for Southern novels this one centers on a character who mixes Yiddish with his Southern and has for his neighbors small merchants from Poland Lebanon and Greece As Morris resides with his family over his Dauphin Street store enjoys cigars with his Cuban friend Pablo Pastor and makes a living not a killing his tale begins with glimpses of the old Confederacy continues through a tumultuous Armistice Day and leads up to the hard won victories of World War II Along the way Morris sells shoes and sofas and endures Klan violence religious zealotry and financial triumphs and heartbreaks With his devoted Miriam who nurses memories of Brooklyn and Romania he raises four adventurous children whose own journeys take them to New Orleans and Atlanta and involve romance ambition and tragic loss At turns lyrical comic and melancholy this tale takes inspiration from its title This Romanian expression with an Alabama twist is symbolic of the strivings of ordinary folks for sustenance for the realization of their hopes and dreams Set largely on a few humble blocks yet engaging many parts of the world this Southern Jewish novel is ultimately richly American

feminist perspective that explores links between the suppressed aspirations of women and madness Perhaps most importantly just as the novel examines the relationship between the wife Miho and her southern island roots Shi no toge parallels Shimao's growing concern over the culture of marginalized regions and notions of cultural diversity a concern that would eventually result in the Yaponesia essays In *Mad Wives and Island Dreams* Gabriel succeeds in linking all of the seemingly disparate strands within Shimao's oeuvre the war stories the byosaimono the dream stories the Yaponesia writings categories all too often discussed in isolation He shows convincingly that together they represent a consistent and concerted attempt to depict the existence of the Other the significant periphery of a less than homogenous whole This volume will prove fascinating and important reading for those interested in questions of cultural identity and marginalization as well as Japanese literature and culture
