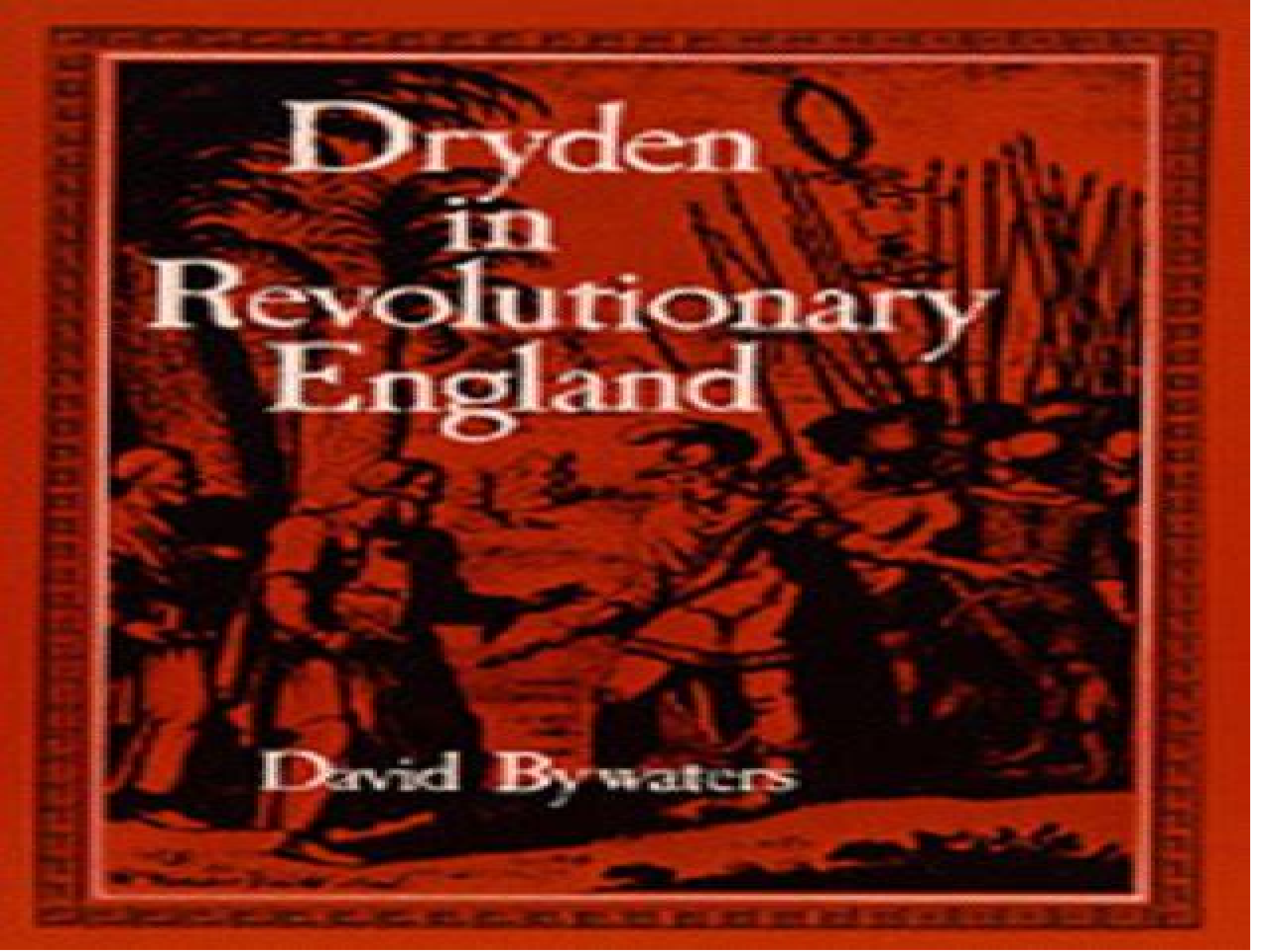

The Practice of Satire in England, 1658-1770 Ashley Marshall, 2013-06-28 An exhaustive study of satire in the long eighteenth century Outstanding Academic Title Choice In The Practice of Satire in England 1658 1770 Ashley Marshall explores how satire was conceived and understood by writers and readers of the period Her account is based on a reading of some 3 000 works ranging from one page squibs to novels The objective is not to recuperate particular minor works but to recover the satiric milieu to resituate the masterpieces amid the hundreds of other works alongside which they were originally written and read The long eighteenth century is generally hailed as the great age of satire and as such it has received much critical attention However scholars have focused almost exclusively on a small number of canonical works such as Gulliver s Travels and The Dunciad and have not looked for continuity over time Marshall revises the standard account of eighteenth century satire revealing it to be messy confused and discontinuous exhibiting radical and rapid changes over time The true history of satire in its great age is not a history at all Rather it is a collection of episodic little histories

Excess and the Mean in Early Modern English Literature Joshua Scodel, 2009-02-09 This book examines how English writers from the Elizabethan period to the Restoration transformed and contested the ancient ideal of the virtuous mean As early modern authors learned at grammar school and university Aristotle and other classical thinkers praised golden means balanced between extremes courage for example as opposed to cowardice or recklessness By uncovering the enormous variety of English responses to this ethical doctrine Joshua Scodel revises our understanding of the vital interaction between

classical thought and early modern literary culture Scodel argues that English authors used the ancient schema of means and extremes in innovative and contentious ways hitherto ignored by scholars Through close readings of diverse writers and genres he shows that conflicting representations of means and extremes figured prominently in the emergence of a self consciously modern English culture Donne for example reshaped the classical mean to promote individual freedom while Bacon held extremism necessary for human empowerment Imagining a modern rival to ancient Rome georgics from Spenser to Cowley exhorted England to embody the mean or lauded extreme paths to national greatness Drinking poetry from Jonson to Rochester expressed opposing visions of convivial moderation and drunken excess while erotic writing from Sidney to Dryden and Behn pitted extreme passion against the traditional mean of conjugal moderation Challenging his predecessors in various genres Milton celebrated golden means of restrained pleasure and self respect Throughout this groundbreaking study Scodel suggests how early modern treatments of means and extremes resonate in present day cultural debates

Douglas Canfield, 2014-10-17 To understand the cultural history of England during the Restoration one need look no further than the theater which was attended by the gentry as well as by members of the middle and lower classes The theater of this period embodied the values meanings and power relations of Restoration England In *Heroes and States* Douglas Canfield argues that drama not only represents but actually helps constitute the value and belief systems of an entire culture *Heroes and States* completes Canfield's two volume cultural history of Restoration drama begun in *Tricksters and Estates On the Ideology of Restoration Comedy* In this second volume Canfield shows how Restoration playwrights attempted to reinscribe late feudal aristocratic ideology after the English Civil War In the serious drama of the period conflict is between noble heroes upon whom states are built and transgressors of the established order tyrants traitors usurpers rapists and atheists Canfield considers several sub genres of tragedy He argues that most of these sub genres reaffirm the older ideology after testing it in the fires of conflict Tragical satire on the other hand the most subversive of these sub genres exposes the failure of the ruling class to live up to its own codes and in some cases the absurdity of the codes themselves Canfield also finds playwrights struggling with issues of race and colonialism He uses the work of modern theorists such as Bakhtin Girard Kristeva Derrida Althusser Williams and Eagleton to illuminate aspects of his inquiries Restoration tragedy stands on the cusp of a cultural transition from a late feudal to an early bourgeois ideology and the issues and themes addressed in the theater validate the culture and politics of seventeenth century England **Dangerous**

Women, Libertine Epicures, and the Rise of Sensibility, 1670-1730 Laura Linker, 2016-05-13 In the first full length study of the figure of the female libertine in late seventeenth and early eighteenth century literature Laura Linker examines heroines appearing in literature by John Dryden Aphra Behn Catharine Trotter Delariviere Manley and Daniel Defoe Linker argues that this figure partially inspired by Epicurean ideas found in Lucretius's *De rerum natura* interrogates gender roles and assumptions and emerges as a source of considerable tension during the late Stuart and early Georgian periods Witty and rebellious the female libertine becomes a frequent satiric target because of her transgressive sexuality As a result of negative portrayals of lady libertines women writers begin to associate their libertine heroines with the pathos figures they read in French texts of sensibility Beginning with a discussion of Charles II's mistresses Linker shows that these women continue to serve as models for the female libertine in literature long after their reigns at court ended Her study places the female libertine within her cultural philosophical and literary contexts and suggests new ways of considering women's participation and the early novel which prominently features female libertines as heroines of sensibility **Otherworldly**
