

Common Mental Health Disorders In Dual Diagnosis

Anxiety Disorders

Persistent worry, often leading to substance use for relief (20% co-occurrence with SUDs)



Mood Disorders

Depression and dysthymia, with substances used to manage emotions (32% co-occurrence with SUDs)



Schizophrenia

Hallucinations and delusions, often paired with substance use (50% co-occurrence with SUDs)



Bipolar Disorder

Mania and depression, with substances used to manage mood swings (40% co-occurrence with SUDs)

Major Depressive Disorder

Low mood, with substances like alcohol or opioids used to self-soothe (20% co-occurrence with SUDs)



Conduct Disorders

Aggressive behavior in youth, often leading to substance use in adulthood



PTSD

Trauma-related symptoms, with substances like alcohol used for relief (46% co-occurrence with SUDs)



ADHD

Inattention and impulsivity, with a higher risk of substance use (twice as likely to develop SUDs)
