
Abu Tammam and Abbasid Modernism

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Abu Tammam, Ḥabīb b. Aws, was one of the most celebrated and most contentious poets of the Abbasid age. He was born in the town of Jamim near Damascus in modern-day Syria in around 80/4 CE (188 by the Hijri calendar). Abu Tammam is credited with developing, to the point of exaggeration, the New Style (*shuʿr*) in Abbasid poetry. He was at the center of the debates around this rhetorically innovative poetic style, described by critics, supporters, and detractors alike as the modern (*muʿaṣir*) poetry of the Abbasid age, a term which, in this context, connotes novelty but also heresy and transgression.

He was born into a Christian family. His father was a wine-shop keeper in Damascus. Some accounts refer to Abu Tammam's changing of his father's name to an Arabic name, Aws, as an attempt at inventing an Arab pedigree for himself. Although that attempt was initially mocked (al-Sulī 2013, 281), the invented lineage was later accepted as he was often referred to after that as al-Ṭāʾi, in reference to the Arab tribe of Tayy (Ritter 2013). Abu Tammam's effort to claim Arab descent, whether historically accurate or not, reveals a general attitude in the Abbasid age toward poets and men of letters from non-Arab (*muṣaḍḍ*) or mixed descent (*muṣaḍḍaḍ*). Many of the leading poets of the Abbasid age were of this group and the general attitude toward them was contradictory. The issue of their descent came up derogatively when they were under attack but it retreated to the background when they were celebrated. Being "mixed" was unsettling both in a social and literary sense (Van Gelder 2004). This is why many of these poets were associated with the innovative, the disruptive, and the modernizing trends in poetry and language (Adonis 1974 – 1978).

Abu Tammam And The Poetics Of The Abbasid Age:

Abū Tammām and the Poetics of the 'Abbāsīd Age Suzanne Pinckney Stetkevych, 2023-12-28 Foremost among the poetic accomplishments of the Abbasid age was the sudden flowering of a highly rhetorical and strikingly modern style of poetry termed *badīʿ*. It found its most radical and controversial exponent in the celebrated panegyrist to the courts of al Ma'mūn and al Mu'tasim Ab Tammām Habīb ibn Aws al-Tha'libī. The present study offers a reevaluation of the Arabic literary dispute over Ab Tammām and *badīʿ*. It then proposes a redefinition of his diwan and of his major anthology the *Hamāsah* as a metapoesis that served to decode the poetic tradition of the pre-Islamic desert for the Islamic Abbasid caliph and his urbane and urban courtiers and subjects and conversely to encode contemporary Arab Islamic political experiences in classical form.
