Rather it is a crucial tool in establishing how to identify and measure what is effective and efficient within the NHS.

Getting value for money from the education of 16- to 18-year-olds Great Britain: National Audit Office, 2011-03-23

Increases in expenditure on education for 16 to 18 year olds which now stands at 6 billion per year have been matched by improvements in students achievements and increasing participation of 16 to 18 year olds in education. Nevertheless the National Audit Office cannot conclude that value for money is being delivered across the system because of variation in the arrangements for accountability, performance monitoring and intervention where poor performance exists. Students achieve on average better academic progress and results in institutions educating large numbers of 16 to 18 year olds whether colleges or school sixth forms. Sixth form colleges perform best on most measures of student achievement despite currently receiving 280 per student less funding than school sixth forms. The Department for Education has taken steps to reduce inconsistency in how different provider types are funded and has committed to bringing the funding levels for school sixth forms into line with colleges by 2015. Although there are clear arrangements for dealing with poor performance in colleges, there is no consistent approach to dealing with poor performance in school sixth forms. In addition, the inspection frameworks and performance and financial reporting requirements for the various types of provider are not consistent. Many schools and colleges have improved their management of back office costs through good practice in procurement. However, direct costs including teaching staff account for over 60 per cent of a provider's costs and some providers have a poor understanding of how to manage these costs.

Public Procurement Regulation in Africa Geo Quinot, Sue Arrowsmith, 2013-01-17 Public procurement regulation in Africa is not widely researched. EU development assistance Great Britain: Parliament: House of Commons: International Development Committee, 2012-04-27 The UK spends approximately 1 23 billion each year on aid through the European Union approximately 16% of the UK's total aid budget Only 46% of this aid however goes to low income countries a figure that MPs say is unacceptable Instead middle income countries bordering Europe are benefiting Turkey has consistently been in the top five recipients of European Commission aid 223 million euros in 2010 as has Serbia euros 218 million in 2010 The Committee is calling on the UK Government to press for funding to be diverted away from higher middle income countries bordering Europe to give greater help to the poorest people in the world In order to make this happen the MPs say Ministers must challenge and change the definition of Official Development Assistance ODA It appears to be being used as a way of fudging the figures to help other European countries meet the target for 0 7% of GDP to be given as aid The Committee recognises that there are a number of advantages to giving aid through the EU but identifies a number of problems with the way EU Development Assistance works Overall the European Commission has improved its performance over the last decade and has recently proposed further improvements to development policy in An Agenda for Change The Committee supports a number of these proposed changes but it does have concerns that conditionality should not hurt the poor for the sins of their governments

National Audit Office - Department of Health: Maternity Services in England - HC 794 Great Britain: National Audit Office, 2013-11-08 Since the Department's 2007 Maternity Matters strategy there has been improvement in maternity services However there is wide variation between trusts in performance The Department did not fully consider the implications of delivering its ambitions and has failed to demonstrate that it satisfactorily considered the achievability and affordability of implementing the strategy Nor has it monitored national progress against it In 2011 one in 133 babies was stillborn or died within several days of birth The mortality rate has fallen over time but comparisons with the other UK nations suggest scope for further improvement Trusts paid 482 million for maternity clinical negligence cover in 2012 13 equating to around a fifth of spending on maternity services The level of consultant presence has substantially improved but over half of maternity units including all of the largest units do not meet recommended levels The NHS is also not meeting a widely recognised benchmark of one midwife to 29 5 births The
