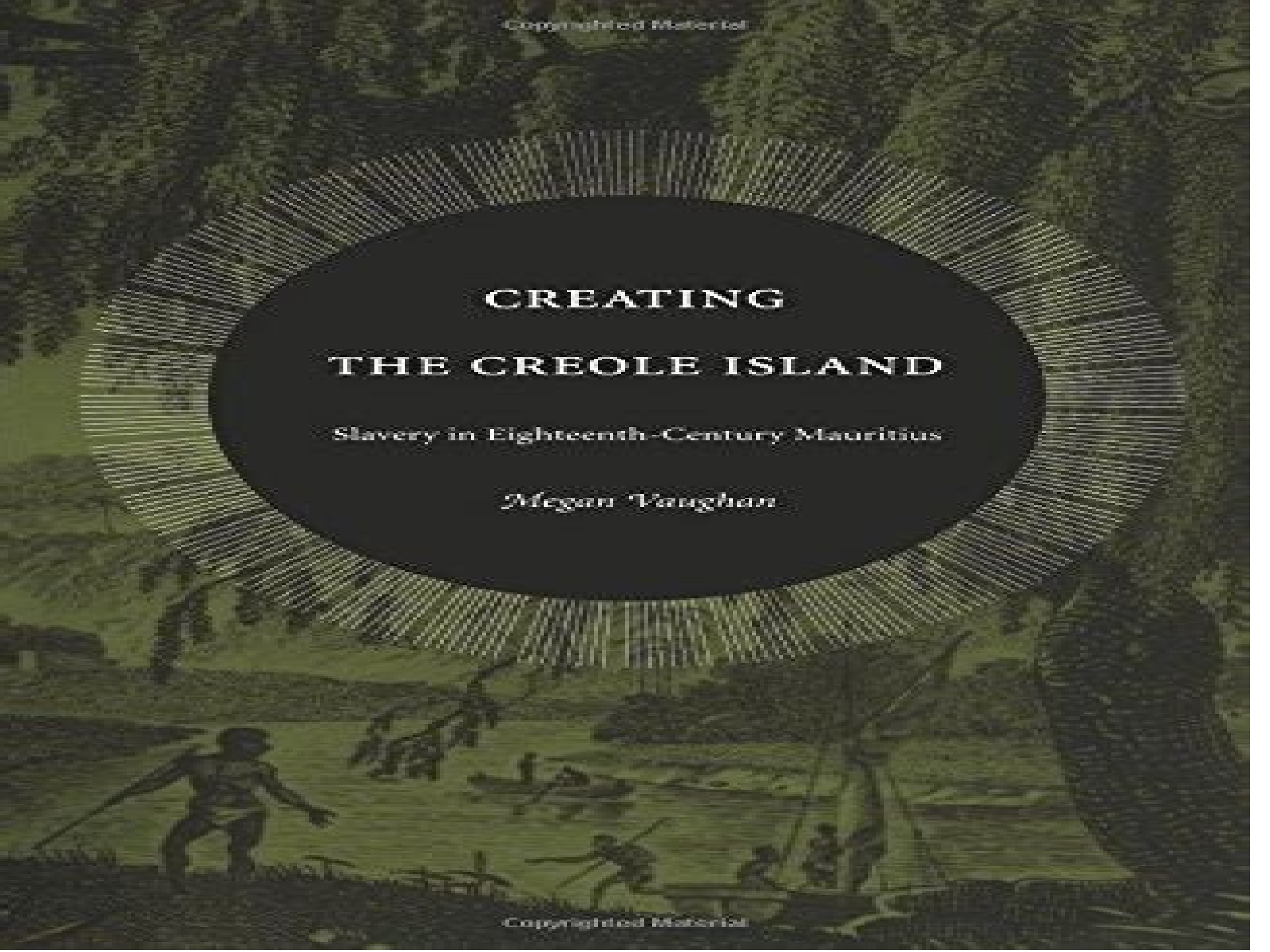




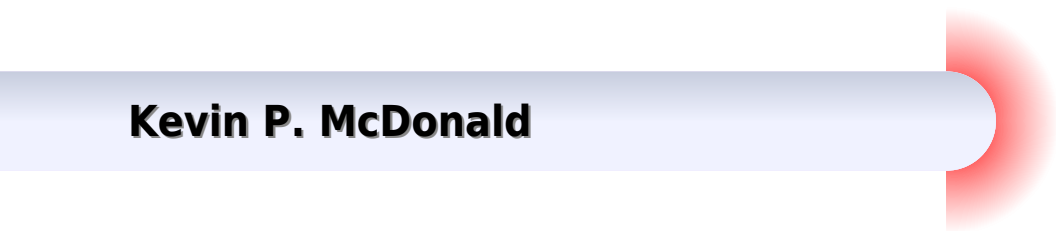

Mixed-race and Modernity in Colonial India Adrian Carton,2012 Focusing on Portuguese British and French colonial spaces this book traces changing concepts of mixed race identity in early colonial India Starting in the sixteenth century it discusses how the emergence of race was always shaped by affiliations based on religion class national identity gender and citizenship across empires In the context of increasing British power the book looks at the Anglo French tensions of the eighteenth century to consider the relationship between modernity and race making Arguing that different forms of modernity produced divergent categories of hybridity it considers the impact of changing political structures on mixed race communities With its emphasis on specificity the book situates current and past debates on the mixed race experience and the politics of whiteness in broader historical and global contexts By contributing to the understanding of race making as an aspect of colonial governance the book illuminates some margins of colonial India that are often lost in the shadows of the British regime It is of interest to academics of world history postcolonial studies South Asian imperial history and critical mixed race studies

Africa Kerala and western India In Across the Green Sea Sanjay Subrahmanyam recounts the history of this ocean from a variety of shifting viewpoints He sets the scene with the withdrawal of China s Ming Dynasty and explores how the western Indian Ocean was transformed by the growth and increasing prominence of the Ottoman Empire and the continued spread of Islam into East Africa He examines how several cities including Mecca and the vital Indian port of Surat grew and changed during these centuries when various powers interacted until famines and other disturbances upended the region in the seventeenth century Rather than proposing an artificial model of a dominant centre and its dominated peripheries Across the Green Sea reveals the complexity of a truly dynamic and polycentric system through the use of connected histories a method which he has pioneered

Transition from Slavery in Zanzibar and Mauritius Teelock, Vijayalakshmi,Peerthum, Satyendra,2017-05-05 This book presents a comparative history of slavery and the transition from slavery to free labour in Zanzibar and Mauritius within the context of a wider comparative study of the subject in the Atlantic and Indian Ocean worlds Both countries are islands with roughly the same size of area and populations a common colonial history and both are multicultural societies However despite inhabiting and using the same oceanic space there are differences in experiences and structures which deserve to be explored In the nineteenth century two types of slave systems developed on the islands while Zanzibar represented a variant of an Indian Ocean slave system Mauritius represented a variant of the Atlantic system yet both flourished when the world was already under the hegemony of the global capitalist mode of production This comparison therefore has to be seen in the context of their specific historical conjunctures and the types of slave systems in the overall theoretical conception of modes of production within which they manifested themselves a concept that has become unfashionable but which is still essential The starting point of many such efforts to compare slave systems has

naturally been the much studied slavery in the Atlantic region which has been used to provide a paradigm with which to study any type of slavery anywhere in the world However while Mauritian slavery was 100 per cent colonial slavery slavery in Zanzibar has been described as Islamic slavery Both established plantation economies although with different products Zanzibar with cloves and Mauritius with sugar and in both cases the slaves faced a potential conflictual situation between former masters and slaves in the post emancipation period

Eviction from the Chagos Islands Sandra Evers, Marry Kooy, 2011-05-27 This book examines the history and contemporary living conditions of Chagossians who were evicted from the Chagos archipelago in the Indian Ocean to make way for a strategic U S military base Initially part of colonial Mauritius Chagos was integrated into a new colony named the British Indian Ocean Territory in 1965 In 1966 Great Britain transferred control of Diego Garcia the largest Chagos island to the Americans under a fifty year lease The expulsions which followed were designed to satisfy the U S demand for an unpopulated territory The Chagossians were thus forced to resettle in Mauritius and the Seychelles where livelihoods are poor and marginalized The Chagossians are currently engaged in a campaign seeking right of return to the archipelago and recognition as a people forced to live in diaspora

Stigma Katherine Dauge-Roth, Craig Koslofsky, 2023-06-23 The early modern period opened a new era in the history of dermal marking Intensifying global travel and trade especially the slave trade brought diverse skin marking practices into contact as never before *Stigma* examines the distinctive skin cultures and marking methods of Asia Europe Africa and the Americas as they began to circulate and reshape one another in the early modern world By highlighting the interwoven histories of tattooing branding stigmata baptismal and beauty marks wounds and scars this volume shows that early modern markers of skin and readers of marked skin did not think about different kinds of cutaneous signs as separate from each other On the contrary Europeans described Indigenous tattooing in North America Thailand and the Philippines by referring their readers to the tattoos Christian pilgrims received in Jerusalem or Bethlehem When explaining the devil s mark on witches theologians claimed it was an inversion of holy marks such as those of baptism or divine stigmata *Stigma* investigates how early modern people used permanent marks on skin to affirm traditional roles and beliefs and how they hybridized and transformed skin marking to meet new economic and political demands In addition to the editors the contributors to this volume are Xiao Chen Ana Fonseca Conboy Peter Erickson Claire Goldstein Matthew S Hopper Katrina H B Keefer Mordechay Lewy Nicole Nyffenegger Mairin Odle and Allison Stedman

McDonald, 2015-03-13 In the late seventeenth and early eighteenth centuries more than a thousand pirates poured from the Atlantic into the Indian Ocean There according to Kevin P McDonald they helped launch an informal trade network that spanned the Atlantic and Indian Ocean worlds connecting the North American colonies with the rich markets of the East Indies Rather than conducting their commerce through chartered companies based in London or Lisbon colonial merchants in New York entered into an alliance with Euro American pirates based in Madagascar Pirates Merchants Settlers and Slaves explores the resulting global trade network located on the peripheries of world empires and shows the illicit ways American colonists met the consumer demand for slaves and East India goods The book reveals that pirates played a significant yet misunderstood role in this period and that seafaring slaves were both commodities and essential components in the Indo Atlantic maritime networks Enlivened by stories of Indo Atlantic sailors and cargoes that included textiles spices jewels and precious metals chinaware alcohol and drugs this book links previously isolated themes of piracy colonialism slavery transoceanic networks and cross cultural interactions and extends the boundaries of traditional Atlantic national world and colonial histories
