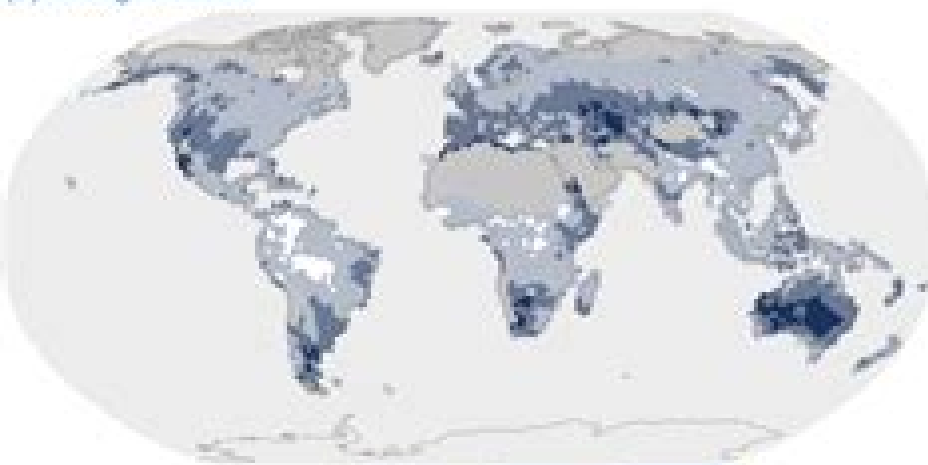

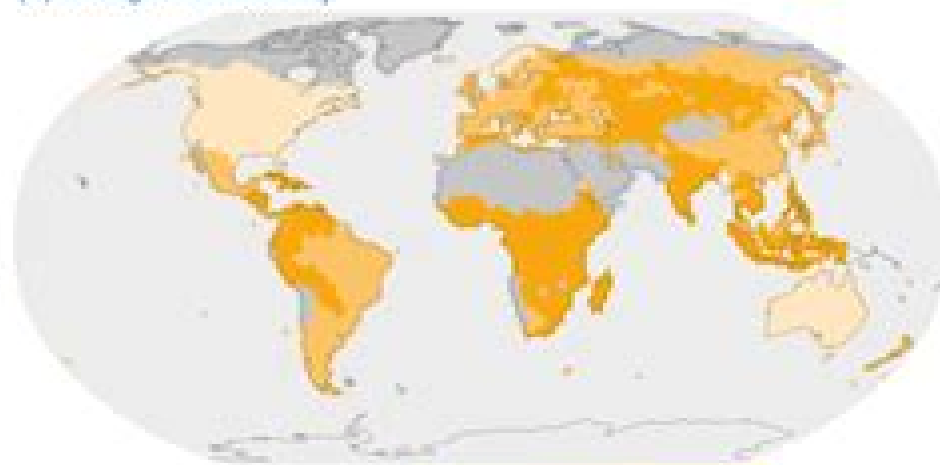

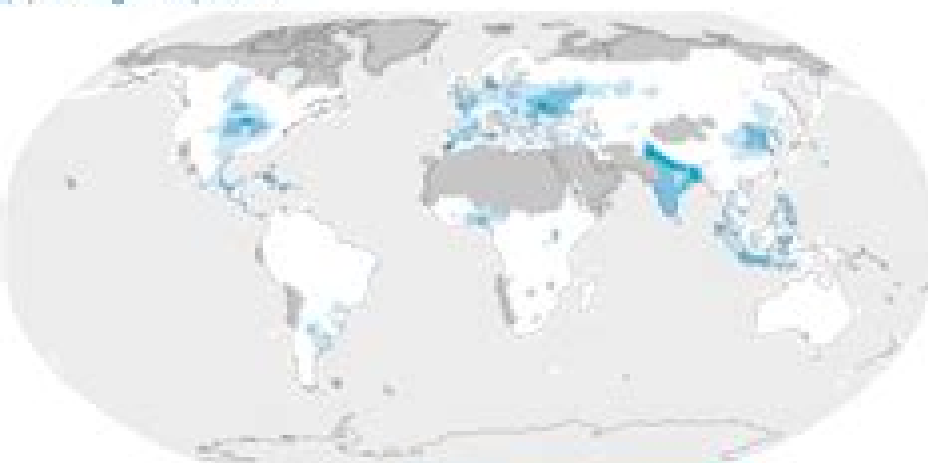

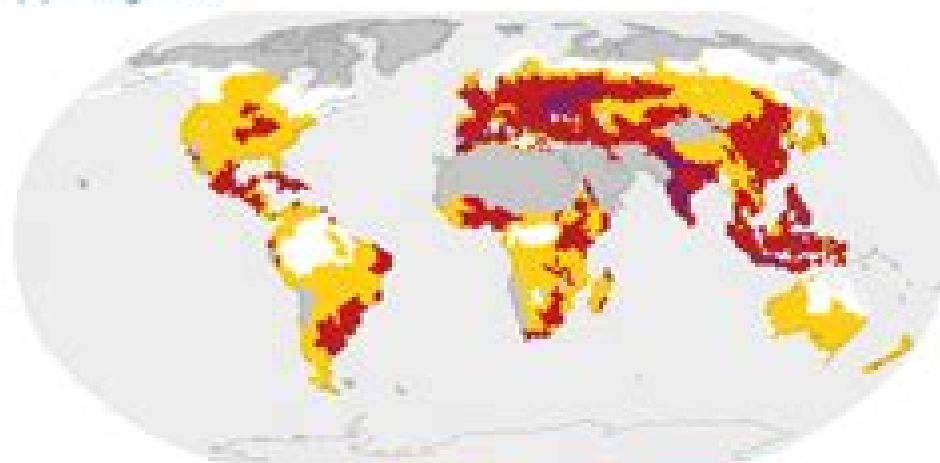
(b) Drought vulnerability
