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break pressure tank is a structure that is located between a water reservoir and supply point with the aim of reducing the pressure in the system to zero atmospheric pressure conventional break pressure tank is constructed of concrete in rectangular shape with the depth of the tank about 1 2m

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break pressure tanks which are usually made of concrete or ferrocement if break pressure tanks are used the hydraulic

gradient starts again at the tank water level if suitably sized these tanks can be used within the system as storage tanks to meet peak demand reservoir storage tanks although a village's water needs are based upon a
